OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- This permit replaces applicant's permit which expired October 7, 1984.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA neview process, it is the staff's opinion that the project is consistent with its use classification.
- 4. The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at take Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas.

A parcel of submerged land in the State owned bed of Lake Tahoe. Placer County, State of California, lying between points 36 and 37 as shown on map sheet 3 of 22 of the survey performed by the State of California, State Lands Commission, State Lands Division, filed in Book 2 of Surveys, page 71, records of said County, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at said point 36 that has coordinates of X = 2,527,249 and Y = 518,225 conforming to the California Coordinate System, Zone II, as shown on said map; thence along the line between said points 36 and 37 N 66° 20' 45" W, a distance of 40.00 fee. to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING: thence N 22° 15' 15" E, a distance f 63.50 feet; thence N 67° 44' 45" W, a distance of 28.00 feet; thence S 22° 15' 15" W, a distance of 500.00 feet; thence S 67° 44' 45" E, a distance of 28.00 feet; thence N 22° 15' 15" E, a distance of 436,50 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark.
