ISSUANCE OF PATENT TRANSFERRING LANDS TO
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

BACKGROUND:

In June 1957, an 80-acre parcel of Bureau of Land Management (BLM) land was clear listed to the State and sold to the Department of Forestry (CDF) to accommodate the Fredrick Peak Lookout Station in Lassen County. The parcel was described utilizing inadequate information at the time of the title transfer. In 1972, a resurvey disclosed that the Lookout Station is actually about one-quarter mile distant from the parcel that was acquired from BLM. In 1981 CDF requested the assistance of the State Lands Commission (SLC) to acquire the title of the lands occupied by the Lookout Station. The SLC at its July 22, 1982 meeting authorized the Executive Officer to enter into and execute the 'Agreement for the Transfer of Control and Possession of State-Owned Real Property' and to enter into the reformation of Clear List 267 with BLM, returning title of the erroneously described parcel in exchange for the title to the parcel actually occupied by the Lookout Station.

CURRENT SITUATION:

1. SLC has received the 'Agreement for the Transfer of Control and Possession of State-Owned Real Property' from CDF for the erroneously described parcel.
2. SLC has patented back to BLM title to the erroneously described parcel (SA 5545).
3. BLM has transferred to SLC title by Clear List 355, to the parcel actually occupied by the Lookout Station as described in the attached Exhibit "A".

PROPOSED ACTION:

1. In order to complete the transfer of title to CDF, authorize the issuance of a patent to the E1/2 of SW1/4 Section 26 T33N R12E, MDM as clear listed to SLC by BLM Clear List 355 to the "State of California, acting by and through the Department of Forestry with the approval of the Director of General Services."

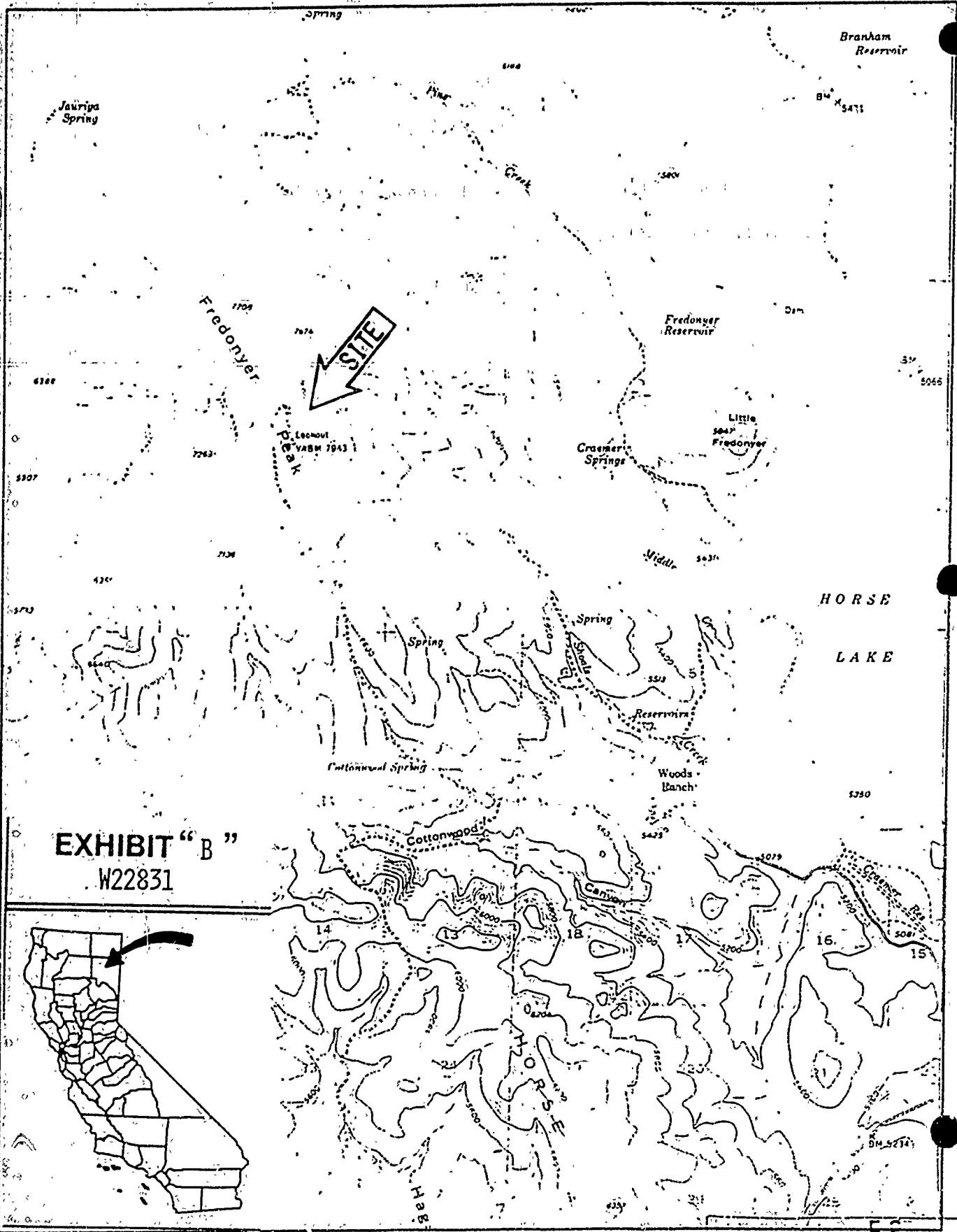
