PROVIDED FOR BY THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES AND
THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION

## BACKGROUND

On April 9, 1979, the staff of the State Lands Commission was notified of a proposed project for a power plant and transmission line in Fresno County. The project involved State-owned lands in the Kings River and within the Central Valley Water Project area. The State Lands Commission approved a permit, PRC 5727.9, to the Kings River Conservation District on June 26, 1980 for the Pine Flat Power Plant. The Department of Water Resources was notified of the need for a permit for the transmission line. Permitting of the line was held up because the Department of Water Resources and the State founds Commission staff were in the process of writing a Memorandum of Understanding relative to the Central Valley Water Project.

On September 26, 1979, the State Lands Commission approved a Memorandum of Understanding, effective October 19, 1979, between the Department of Water Resources and the State Lands Commission. It provides for use of State lands for either the Central Valley Project or the State Water Resources Development System. Under the Memorandum of Understanding, the Department of Water Resources provides State Lands Commission with a "Notice of Proposed Use of State Lands".

The Department of Water Resources has recently submitted the prescribed Notice for the existing transmission line which extends from the Pine Flat Power Plant switch and interconnects with Pacific Gas and Electric Company's 230kv transmission line. Staff has reviewed the project plan and determined that no restrictions or limitations are needed from State Lands Commission. An EIR, which addressed the power plant and transmission line, was completed and a Notice of Determination was filed by Department of Water Resources on March 27, 1979. The Department of Water Resources received the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approval for the project on March 24, 1980.
