CALENDAR ITEM

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AWARD OF ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRACT, STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE E+392, HUNTINGTON BEACH FIELD, ORANGE COUNTY

On February 28, 1985 the Commission authorized the competitive bid sale of royalty oil produced from State Oil and Gas Lease E-392. Huntington Beach Field. The royalty oil is currently being purchased by Edgington Oil Company under a contract which will expire on May 1, 1985. The State's share of royalty oil produced from State Oil and Gas Lease E-392 is approximately 1,000 barrels per day of 190 API gravity crude oil.

On March 15, 1985 the staff offered by competitive public bid the royalty oil production from State Oil and Gas Dease E-392. Attached as Exhibit And is a list of the bidders and their bonus bids in dollars per barrel above the base price. The base price is the highest price posted (among the postings of Chevron, Union, Mobil and Texaco) for like crude oil in the Huntington Beach Field on the day of delivery.

The Commission staff has reviewed the financial ability of the bidders to fulfill the obligations of the contract and their physical ability to take the oil, and has determined the highest responsible bidder, which is identified on Exhibit "A", The contract, if awarded, will be for a term of 18 months, with delivery commencing on May 1, 1985. Delivery of the oil will be by exchange agreement without any change in the existing oil production and transportation facilities.
