ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE AND DEFERMENT OF DRILLING FOR STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 6192, SUISUN-HONKER AREA, SOLANO COUNTY

AREA, TYPE, LAND AND LOCATION:

7,367 acres of tide and submerged lands contained within State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 6192, Grizzly Island-Montezuma Slough Area, Solano Couny.

LEASE SUMMARY:

State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 6192, was issued to Shell Oil Company on October 28, 1982. This lease was subsequently assigned to Shell Western E&P, Inc. on January 1, 1984. Shell Western E&P, Inc. desires to assign the lease to Hershey Oil Corporation, a California Corporation. Hershey Oil Corporation has applied to the State Lands Commission for approval of this lease assignment. Staff review of the financial statements for Hershey disclosed nothing material that would indicate they do not have the financial ability to meet the lease obligations with the State. Hershey has submitted the required performance bond (\$100,000).

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Assignment forms have been executed by Shell Western E&P, Inc. (Assigner) and Hershey Oil Corporation (Assignee) and they request that the State Lands Commission consent to the assignment of this lease.

Hershey Oil Corporation has also applied to the Commission for the approval of a deferment of the drilling term of three years which expires on October 28, 1985 and Hershey has requested deferment of the lease 120-day continuous drilling obligation until May 1, 1986.

Hershey and Shell E&P, Inc. as joint partners drilled a well on the leased lands on June 17, 1984 which was later abandoned on July 26, 1984. Hershey is requesting the drilling deferment to allow it to do more seismic exploration and detailed geologic analysis of the previous well and new seismic data prior to drilling another well.
