NINTH MODIFICATION OF THE 1984-1985 PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD LOS ANGELES COUNTY

The City of Long Beach has requested approval of the Ninth Modification of the 1984-1985 Plan of Development and Operations and Budget, Long Beach Unit. This modification would transfer funds between two Budget Items in different Budget Programs. The total adjusted budget would remain unchanged at \$251,278,000.

Water injection is now forecast at 237 million barrels for the current year, more than ten percent greater than the estimate used in preparing the budget. An additional \$750,000 is needed in the Water Injection System Budget Item to cover the cost of the increased energy needed to pressure the greatest part of the injected water which is handled by Unit pumps.

No augmentation of the Budget is required since funds are available in the Oil Gathering System Budget Item. These funds were provided for a project which has been deferred for additional study of the alternatives available.

Upon approval the affected budget items will be as follows:
