Salvage of silver and artifacts from a sunken

vessel, or vessels, at Owens Lake.

(Approved under Item C10; 10 10 10 10 10 10 TERMS OF EXISTING PERMIT: December 26, 1984)

Initial period: One year beginning January 1, 1985.

Public liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$300,000.

CONSIDERATION:

\$940 land rent, and 25 percent of the net salvage value of \$25,000 or less, and 50 percent of the net value in excess of

\$25,000. Said sum shall be due on the first of the month following the sale and bear interest at the rate of 12 percent per annum, if not paid within 15 days of the due date.

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TERMS OF ASSIGNMENT:

Spacecraft Engineering proposes to assign its corporate leasehold and salvage rights to Mr. Dale Newman, an individual, effective March 1, 1985, to carry out the covenants, conditions, and agreements contained in existing permit PRC 6765, as adopted by the commission on December 26, 1984. The company is closing down and the Applicant, as sole owner thereof, will succeed to the provisions of this permit by this transaction.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: P.R.C. 21065 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15378.

2. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to p.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such

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declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project sconsistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal: Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.
