OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATIONS

1. The proposed permit is requested by the Department of Fish and Game because the area has significant value as a breeding and nesting habitat. They plan to initiate a management program to preserve and enhance the wildlike habitat through a staged development program.

To summarize the program; small earth moving equipment will be used to divert fresh water from Davis Creek for additional wetlands, namely, contour ditches and small ponds with low check dams. Cover crop planting and food plants are to be introduced where necessary to create nesting cover and provide food. Nesting platforms will be placed for Canadian Geese.

When the waterfowl are well established, plans are to introduce controlled limited public hunting.

An important aspect of the management program is a controlled grazing program. This will entail rotating cattle grazing by enclosing off 100 acre parcels to maintain a desirable level of foliage.

To effect the necessary grazing control, staff recommends that the Commission approve a grazing lease to Crane Creek Cattle Company

It is Calendar Item 17 appearing on the agenda of today's Commission meeting.

An agreement which will include notification of land enclosure to Crane Creek Cattle Company and State Lands Commission will be required. Notification is necessary for mental payment adjustment by State Lands Commission and future business planning for the Crane Creek Cattle Company.

Rease PRC 6733.1, an existing grazing Tease, extends over 38 acres of the requested permit area however no control is necessary due to small acreage.

- The annual rental value of the site is 2:. estimated to be \$196.776.
- This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQN revi a process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304(d).


