BACKGROUND

On August 26, 1982, Minute Item No. 19, the State Lands Commission approved a Master Lease to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) for various electrical energy distribution facilities located throughout the State.

The Master Lease allows for changes and new facilities to be added by an addendum to the Master Lease. The lease further specifies that no filing or processing fees shall be required for minor modifications to the lease.

CURRENT SITUATION:

PG&E has requested that a proposed power line across the south fork of the Kings River be included in the Master Lease. The power line is to provide service to a five-horsepower lift pump owned by PG&E's applicant, J. G. Boswell Company.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period:

30 years beginning

September 1, 1982.

Renewal options:

One successive period of

15 years.

LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 6205

A strip of land 10 feet wide in the bed of the South Fork of the Kings River in Section 18, T2OS, R2OE, MDM, near Stratford, Kings County, California, the centerline of said strip being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the east line of Section 19, TOOS, R20E, MDM, from which the NE corner of said tion 19 bears North, 19 feet; thence from said moint of beginning N 89° 40' W, 214 feet; thence % 79° 38' W, 610 feet to the end of the herein described line.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water marks of said South Fork of the Kings River.
