Initial period:

49 years beginning September 10, 1984.

The public benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

TERMS OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

This addition of the lands shown on Exhibit "A" to be designated as Parcel 2 of General Permit

No. 6747.

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's hest interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The Applicant has an existing permit, covering a 0.93+-acre parcel of sowereign land, for the placement and maintenance of riprap to repair levees at Snodgrass Slough.
- 2. Under the present application, the Bureau of Reclamation proposes the addition of approximately 700 lineal feet of riprap in four small strips not previously covered, for additional levee protection at those locations.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration of Land. 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(d)(2).

Authority P.R.C. 21034, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 153CJ, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

- 4. Due to minimum staff time required for this transaction and in view of the benefits which the work will bring, staff recommends all processing fees be waived.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- 6. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
