- The County of Yuba plans to widen and rehabilitate Simpson Lane Bridge, a county roadway, spanning the Yuba River near Marysville. Work will be completed before October 15 to comply with Department of Fish and Game requirements.
- Lease language conforms to the Lyon/Fogerty decision.
- The annual rental value of the site is 3. estimated to be \$100.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facility, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15301(e)(1).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
