APPROVAL OF A GENERAL PERMIT - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE

APPLICANT:

Western Waterways, Inc.

2000 Glen Cove Road

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.284-acre parcel of tide and submerged land located in Old River at Holland Tract, C. 4 %

Costa County.

LAND USE:

Installation and maintenance of a floating

breakwater.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

15 years beginning August 1,

1985.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$300,000.

CONSIDERATION:

\$450 per annum; with the State reserving the

right to fix a different rental on each fifth

anniversary of the lease.

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

Applicant is permittee of upland.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The applicant proposes to install a 45' x 275' floating tire breakwater secured to piling for wave action protection. Boat sheds that are a part of Holland Riverside Marina will benefit from this protective measure. Terms of the permit allow the applicant one year to install the breakwater facility.
- 2. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmentally significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304.

- 2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO WESTERN WATERWAYS, INC. OF A 15-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 1985; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$450, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$300,000; FOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FLOATING BREAKWATER ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

LAND DESCRIPTION

A parcel of tide and submerged land in Old River, Contra Costa County, California, said parcel lying immediately beneath a floating tire breakwater as shown on U.S.C.E. Public Notice No. 8811, said breakwater being easterly of Holland Riverside Harbor in Lot 52 of Holland Tract, and ajacent to and northerly of the land described in the deed recorded September 5, 1962 in Book 4196, Page 192, Official Records of Contra Costa County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Old River.
