> AWARD OF ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRACT. STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 186, BELMONT OFFSHORE FIELD, ORANGE COUNTY

On August 29, 1985 the State Lands Commission authorized the Competitive Bid Sale of royalty oil produced from State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 186, Belmont Offstore Field, Orange County. royalty oil is currently being purchased by Edgington Oil Company under a contract which will expire on November 1, 1985. Edgington Oil Company is paying the State a bonus of \$1.8610 per barrel above the Base Price. The State's share of royalty oil produced from this lease is approximately 300 barrels per day of 190 API gravity crude oil.

On September 16, 1985 the Staff offered by competitive public bid the royalty production from this lease. The successful bidder will be the responsible bidder making the highest per barrel bonus bid over the base price. Attached as Exhibit "A" is a list of the bidders and their bonus bids in dollars per barrel over the base price Ine base price is the highest price posted for like crude oil in the Belmont Offshore Field on the day of delivery.

The Commission staff has reviewed the financial ability of the bidders to fulfill the obligations of the contract and their physical ability to take the oil and has determined that the contract, if awarded, should be awarded to medior Religion; Company who has offered to pay the telete a brides of \$60 to go.
