OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The Department of Food and Agriculture has requested State Lands Commission authorization to build levees and other appurtenant structures at two pond sites in the Sacramento River south of Redding to eradicate the growth of hydrilla plants. By proclamation dated October 23, 1985, the Governor of the State of California has declared this project to be an emergency. Therefore, Commission staff requests authorization to issue a permit to the Department of Food and Agriculture for this hydrilla weed eradication project.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a statutory exempt project. The project is exempt because it involves a specific action to prevent or mitigate an emergency.

Authority: P.R.C. 21080(b)(4) and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15269(c).





"Dog Pond" Hydrilla Eradication Project

The project area is located in Shasta County on the east (left) bank of the Sacramento River, directly across from the mouth of Clear Creek. The area is not sectionalized and its location will be described as being 2,000 feet east of the western boundary of R4W and 5,150 feet north of the south boundary of T31N, MDB6M.

The project consists of a California Department of Fish and Game pond identified as "Dog Pond", 2.5 acres in area, that has been infiltrated with the hydrilla plant, whose growth is to be eradicated. The basic plan is to extend an existing levee adjacent to the pond to provide erosion projection. The water in the pand will then be pumped into another adjacent pond which also contains the hydrilla plant. The dewatered pond will be sprayed with herbicide and then backfilled.

The specific work to be done is as follows:

- o The existing levee will be extended northward (upstream) approximately 300 feet to a natural abutment and will have a crest 12 feet wide with a minimum riverside slope of 3:1 and a pand side slope of 2:1.
- o The levee will be constructed of +3-inch aggregate with its crest at the same level as the existing levee.
- o A coffer dam using gravel in the Sacramento River will be formed around the levge site to contain sediment.
- The foundation will be stripped to the existing river gravel layer.
- o A 3-foot-thick layer of gravel will be placed on the pond side of the extended levee.
- o The pond will then be dewatered and sprayed with herbicide (to be done by California Department of Agriculture).
- The pond will be backfilled to the level of the levee crest with the top 3 feet consisting of gravel containing up to 3-inch fize aggregate. The lower portion will be filled with random material similar to that found in the nearby gravel plant waste piles.

A similar project is proposed at the Tenney Sand and Gravel site, located about 0.5 miles downstream from the Shea site, on the west (right) bank of the Sacramento River. One pond is involved.

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PROCLAMATION

OF A

STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, GEORGE DEUKMEJIAN, Gererror of the State of California, find that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the State of California as a result of finding the aquatic weed known as hydrilla near the Sacramento River in Shasta County on September 13, 1985.

Hydrilla has been declared a "noxious weed" by the United States Department of Agriculture because, among other things, it spolls water quality, destroys wildlife habitat, clogs and damages waterways, and threatens water supply to persons and communities which draw from bodies of water infested by hydrilla.

Because the grow's pattern of this weed is so prolific, the eradication measures required exceed the capabilities of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County and having now been requested by the Board of Supervisors of said County, I the proclaim the existence of a state of emergency in the County of Shasta and direct the State Department of Food and Agriculture to expeditiously take the appropriate steps to eradicate this hydrill's problem.

I FURTHER DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible, this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.
