 in San Elijo Lagoon, City of Cardiff, San Diego

LAND USE: Operation and maintenance of San Elijo Nature

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On March 13, 1985, Commission staff received an application from the County of San Diego, Department of Parks and Recreation, for a General Permit - Public Agency Use, to construct the proposed Nature Center at the San Elijo Lagoon Regional Park and Ecological Reserve.
2. The site currently contains an abandoned concrete sewage tank and a circular cement pad. The proposed project includes the construction of a nature interpretative center utilizing the concrete tank, accessory parking for cars, buses, and bicycles utilizing the cement pad, restroom and staffing facilities, a resident Park Ranger (RV-type) pad, and improvement of trails. No structures exist or will be constructed on the waterway. Construction of the improvements must begin by July 1, 1987, and be completed by March 1, 1988.
3. The Nature Center will provide an opportunity to generate maintenance revenue for the Regional Park and Ecological Reserve through parking fees, entrance fees or donations by visitors, and possibly by sale of educational literature or miscellaneous items associated with the Lagoon.
4. The Nature Center may be operated with assistance by one or more local community and research organizations. The proposed Permit provides that any signs or other types of printed notices installed to provide notification of public use and benefit, shall include the State Lands Commission as a contributor of the lands underlying the project.

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5. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$594.
6. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.
7. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by the County of San Diego. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document and believes that it complies with the requirements of the CEQA.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO OF A 49-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE, BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 1985; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$1,000,000; FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF SAN ELIJO NATURE CENTER ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

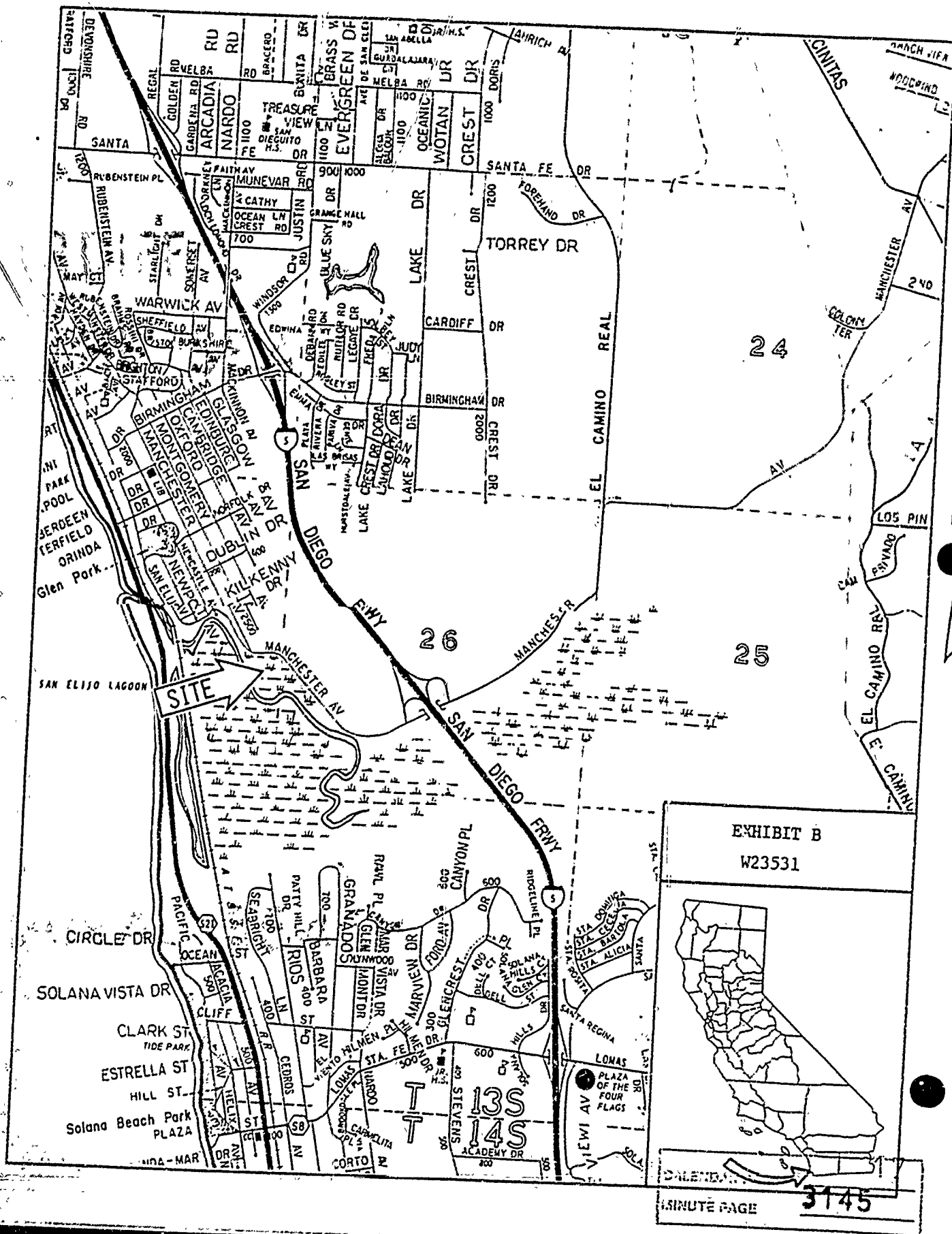

NOTICE OF NEGATIVE DECLARATION

FINDING:

The County of San Diego, Planning & Environmental Review Board (PERB), has examined the Initial Study and finds that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment, and that an Environmental Impact Report need not be prepared pursuant to the San Diego County Procedures for Environmental Impact Review, revised August 1, 1983.

INITIAL STUDY SUMMARY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION:

The proposed project is a major use permit for development of a 1.3 acre nature center at San Elijo Regional Park. The proposed project will be constructed around a used concrete tank which will be used as a lookout tower. Other structures proposed include parking areas, restrooms, a garden, a storage area, and a nature trail. Future use of the site may include a trailer for a resident caretaker. The site is located on Manchester Avenue, west of 15, directly across from the San Elijo Waste Water Treatment Facility.

ENVIRONMENTAL SETTING:

The project site is adjacent to San Elijo Lagoon. The project site is a level bench which has been used in the past as a water treatment facility. A functional pump station remains on the site located directly east of the proposed park development. A sewer line, an access road, and numerous concrete foundations are also present. Soil of the area is Corralitos loamy sand. Much of the vegetation onsite is non-native. A deposit of shell midden of cultural origin is located in a road cut along Manchester Avenue.

POTENTIALLY SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS:

Visitors using the foot trail from the nature center could result in adverse impacts to migratory and resident birds. Future widening of Manchester or other park developments could result in impacts to an archaeological site.

MITIGATING MEASURES PROPOSED BY APPLICANT:


Prior to use in reliance on the major use permit, Parks and Recreation will prepare a plan for monitoring to determine if any sensitive species are nesting or attempting to nest in or near the impact area and to take measures to avoid impacts to sensitive waterfowl to the satisfaction of Environmental Planning.

REASONS TO SUPPORT FINDING OF NEGATIVE DECLARATION:

Future development or widening of Manchester will require mitigation of the impacts to the archaeological site. The present project will not impact the site other than through landscaping which will be hand done and should have minimal impacts. Monitoring will assure that the impact to wildlife is minimal.
