AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
Approximately a 1.73-acre parcel of sovereign
land located in the Kings River, Tulare County.

LAND USE: Highway purposes pursuant to Section 101.5, of
the Streets and Highways Code, specifically to
widen and improve the Highway 99 crossing of
Kings River.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Indefinite period from November 21, 1985.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Staff received a Public Notice from the United States Army Corps of Engineers regarding a proposed project to widen and improve the Highway 99 crossing of the Kings River. Staff notified the Department of Transportation of the need to obtain a permit under Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code.
2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$2,400.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facility, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15301(a)(1).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300.

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS A CATEGORICAL EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITY, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15301(a)(1).
2. AUTHORIZE APPROVAL OF THE MAP FILED BY CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 101.5 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
