EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION OF FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS RELATING TO THE SITING OF HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES ON STATE LANDS

On May 23, 1985, the Commission suspended further consideration of applications related to the siting of hazardous waste management facilities on State lands until September 30, 1985. This action was based on the fact that legislation designed to shape hazardous waste management programs in California was in a great state of flux; and, the need for the Commission to consider information requirements and/or criteria for considering such applications.

The key policy and technical issues of hazardous waste management in California have not been resolved during the 1985 legislative session, but will be back before the Legislature in 1986. Additional time is also needed for staff to develop Commission requirements and criteria. The circumstances remain as they were in May of this year.
