AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO FOURTH OF JULY YACHT CLUB OF AN AMENDMENT AND RENEWAL OF A FIVE-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE, LEASE PRC 6444, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1986; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$711, FOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF LEASE PRC 6444 ARE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the Pacific Ocean at Fourth of July Cove on the northeasterly shore of Santa Catalina Island, Los Angeles County, California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the landward centerline of an existing pier having California Coordinate System, Zone 7 coordinates of x=4,135,730 and y=3,911,325; thence the following eleven courses:
