## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The City of Reedley has applied to the State Lands Commission for a permit to upgrade an existing park and boat launching facility located in the City of Reedley called Cricket Hollow Park. The portion of the project to be located on State land involves installation of boulder riprap to control erosion, renovation of the existing boat ramp, and the installation of a new ramp and floats.
- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to by \$15.
- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CECA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 4. A Negative Declaration and Supplemental Negative Declaration were prepared and adopted for this project by the City of Reedley. The state Lands Commission's staff has reviewed these documents and believes they comply with the requirements of the CEQA.


