Adm. Code 2905(a)(2).

## LAND DESCRIPTION

Those tide and submerged lands in the bed of Steamboat Slough, Sacramento County, California, described as follows:

All that land lying immediately beneath riprap placed for bank protection along the left bank of said Steamboat Slough, said riprap being adjacent to that land described as Lot 7 of Simpson Tract, in the map filed for record in Book 74 of Records Maps, Page 27, Sacramento County Records, TOGETHER WITH all that land lying immediately beneath a mooring area containing four pilings and extending 35 feet into said Steamboat Slough and 30 feet along said slough, said mooring area being immediately adjacent to and westerly of said Lot 7.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion thereof lying landward of the ordinary high water mark.
