OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The State Department of Transportation has submitted an application for the required right-of-way over State sovereign lands to widen Interstate Highway 5, including the San Dieguito Bridge, and rock slope protection at the north bridge abutment in the City of San Diego.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$270.
- An environmental analysis document was prepared, circulated, and adopted for this project by California Coastal Commission as provided under P.R.C. 21080.5 and 14 Cal. Adm. 15251(c).

The staff of the State Lands Commission has reviewed such environmental analysis document and believes that the conditions have been met for the Commission to use the document as an EIR substitute as a Responsible Agency as provided under r4 Cal. Adm. Code 15253.

This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.




### STANDARD CONDITIONS:

- 1. Notice of Receipt and Acknowledgement. The permit is not valid and development shall not commence until a copy of the permit, signed by the permittee or authorized agent, acknowledging receipt of the permit and acceptance of the terms and conditions, is returned to the Commission office.
- 2. Expiration. If development has not commenced, the permit will expire two years from the date on which the Commission voted on the application. Development shall be pursued in a diligent manner and completed in a reasonable period of time. Application for extension of the permit must be made prior to the expiration date.
- 3. Compliance. All development must occur in strict compliance with the proposal as set forth below. Any deviation from the approved plans must be reviewed and approved by the staff and may require Commission approval.
- Interpretation. Any questions of intent or interpretation of any condition will be resolved by the Executive Director or the Commission.
- 5. <u>Inspections</u>. The Commission staff shall be allowed to inspect the site and the development during construction, subject to 24-hour advance notice.
- 6. Assignment. The permit may be assigned to any qualified person, provided assignee files with the Commission an affidavit accepting all terms and conditions of the permit.
- 7. Terms and Conditions Run with the Land. These terms and conditions shall be perpetual, and it is the intention of the Commission and the permittee to bind all future owners and possessors of the subject property to the terms and conditions.

### SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. Wetlands Restoration. Prior to the transmittal of the amendment for the subject development, the applicant shall submit for the review and approval in writing of the Executive Director, a delineation and biological survey covering the precise limits of any herein affected wetlands area. The biological survey shall be reviewed for comments by the State Dept. of Fish and Game. Further, prior to the transmittal of the amendment for the subject development, the applicant shall submit for the review and approval in writing of the Executive Director, in consultation with the State Dept. of Fish and Game, a candidate area for wetlands restoration, and a detailed restoration plan for that area. The total area for restoration shall not be less than one \$1) acre and shall be provided at a ratio of restored area to impacted area of not less than 4:1.
