PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
An approximate 1.326-acre parcel of sovereign
land, located in the San Joaquin River, Fresno
and Madera counties.

LAND USE: Highway purposes pursuant to Section 101.5 of
the Streets and Highways Code, specifically
continued use and occupation of lands
underlying an existing bridge on State
Route 41, crossing the San Joaquin River.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Indefinite period from January 1, 1986.

CONSIDERATION: As set forth by Section 101.5, Streets and
Highways Code and the public use and benefit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Staff received a notice from the California Department of Transportation (DOT) in April, 1985, regarding a proposed project to improve the Route 41. No record of a permit for the bridge was found and, therefore, staff notified DOT of the need to obtain a permit under Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code. The improvement project has been delayed indefinitely, but a permit is needed for the existing bridge. When and if the improvement project is funded, DOT will amend the subject permit as needed.
2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$477.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facility, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

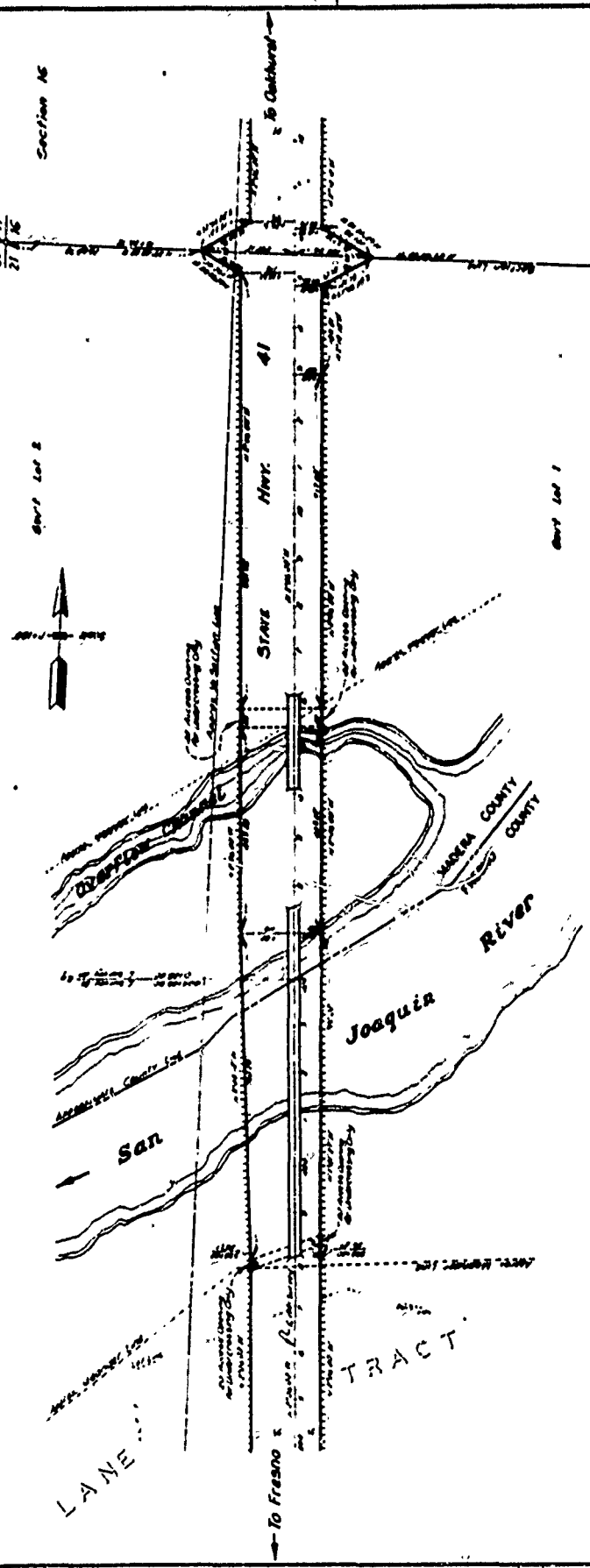
1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS A CATEGORICAL EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITY, 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905(a)(2).
2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.
3. APPROVE THE MAP FILED BY CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 101.5 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF A PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FOR AN INDEFINITE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1986; FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

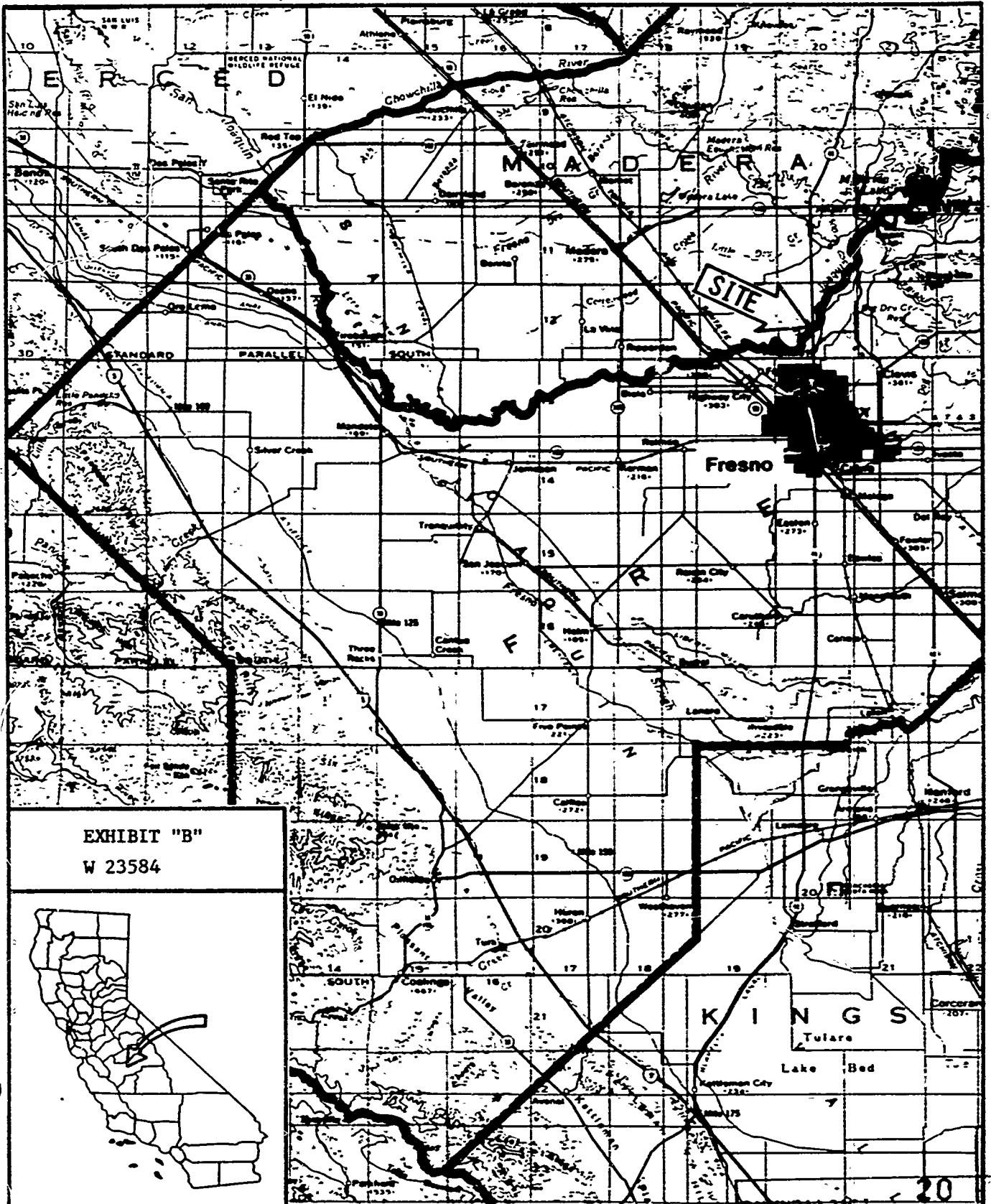
