AMENDMENT OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT TO ADD ONE PARCEL OF  
STATE SCHOOL LAND TO BE MANAGED AS DEMONSTRATION  
FOREST ON BEHALF OF THE COMMISSION BY THE  
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY, SHASTA COUNTY

In June 1980, the Commission authorized entering into an Interagency agreement whereby the California Department of Forestry (CDF) would manage ten State school land parcels on behalf of the Commission. On April 28, 1983, the original agreement was amended to include eight additional parcels of State school land.

CDF has now requested an amendment to the original agreement to include one more State school land parcel. We have been advised that this parcel is adjacent to a parcel which is already under CDF management at Summit City in Shasta County. The parcel currently under management has been used to demonstrate planting techniques and survival and growth rates of native and introduced tree species. CDF feels that the initial results are very promising for this area in the "tension zone" between the chaparral and low elevation conifer vegetation types and would like to expand into the adjacent parcel to try some new species and corroborate initial successes in the existing parcel.

It is proposed to amend the existing agreement by adding the parcel described in Exhibit "A" subject to the same terms and conditions within Interagency Agreement No. LCO380B and with a requirement that a management plan be submitted for Commission approval prior to July 1, 1987. In addition a supplement to the program EIR and other approvals will be met by CDF prior to the Commission's approval of the management plan and authorization to proceed.

AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT LCO380B WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY WHEREBY THE PARCEL OF STATE SCHOOL LAND DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO IS ADDED UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT. NO ACTIVITIES ARE TO OCCUR ON SAID PARCEL UNTIL A MANAGEMENT PLAN COVERING THE ADDITIONAL PARCEL IS SUBMITTED FOR COMMISSION APPROVAL PRIOR TO JULY 1, 1987.

PARCEL 19

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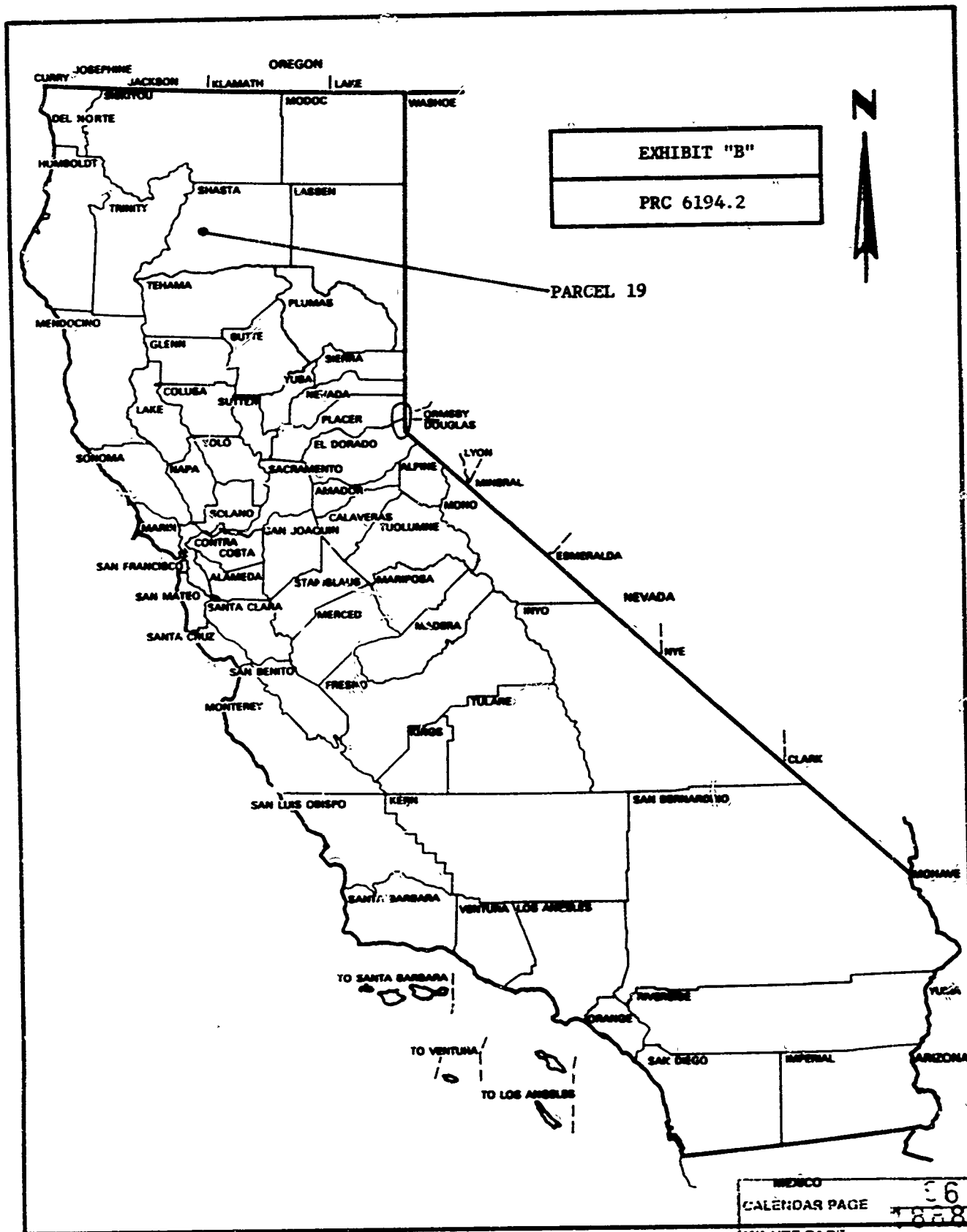
