GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: Marin County Parks and  
Recreation Department  
and  
State of California Wildlife  
Conservation Board  
Civic Center, Room 335  
San Rafael, California 94903

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
A 2.984+-acre parcel of tide and submerged  
land, located at McNears Beach Park, in  
San Pablo Bay, San Rafael, Marin County.

LAND USE: Construction and maintenance of a public  
fishing pier.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Initial period: 25 years beginning  
September 1, 1986.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit; with the State  
reserving the right at any time to set a  
monetary rental if the Commission finds such  
action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:  
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

APPLICANT STATUS:  
Applicant is owner of upland.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:  
Filing fee and processing costs have been  
received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The project is to construct a 500-foot long concrete public fishing pier, with a 120-foot tee at the end. The pier will be located at McNear's Beach Park, which presently contains public recreation facilities.
2. Funds for this project are being obtained from the State of California Wildlife Conservation Board. The Board is required to control some proprietary interest in this type project prior to the granting of any funds, therefore, the proposed public agency permit names the Board as a co-permittee.
3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. but will not affect those significant lands.
4. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by Marin County. The State Lands Commission staff has reviewed such document and believes that it complies with the requirements of the CEQA.

United States Army Corp of Engineers; and State Water Quality Control Board.

FURTHER APPROVALS REQUIRED:

San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 03 (CONT'D)

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY WILL INVOLVE LANDS IDENTIFIED AS POSSESSING SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ., BUT THAT SUCH ACTIVITY WILL HAVE NO DIRECT OR INDIRECT EFFECT ON SUCH LANDS.
2. FIND THAT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION WAS PREPARED AND ADOPTED FOR THIS PROJECT BY MARIN COUNTY AND THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN.
3. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT, AS APPROVED, WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO MARIN COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND STATE OF CALIFORNIA WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD, AS CO-PERMITTEES OF A 25-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 1986; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A PUBLIC FISHING PIER ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

W 23762

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of San Pablo Bay adjacent to McNear's Beach, Marin County, California, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the northeasterly boundary of the lands conveyed to the County of Marin by a deed recorded August 20, 1970 in Book 2396 of the Official Records of Marin County at Page 281, said point lies N 40°50'02" W 302.37 feet from the most easterly point in the boundary of said lands as said boundary is shown on a Survey of McNear County Park filed for record in Book 12 of Surveys at Page 17, Official Records of Marin County; thence from said point of beginning along the northeasterly boundary of said lands of the County of Marin, N 40°50'02" W 177.46 feet, thence N 19°50'02" W 81.04 feet; thence leaving said boundary N 66°49'35" E 534.17 feet; thence S 23°10'25" E 250.00 feet; thence S 66°49'35" W 485.05 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of San Pablo Bay.

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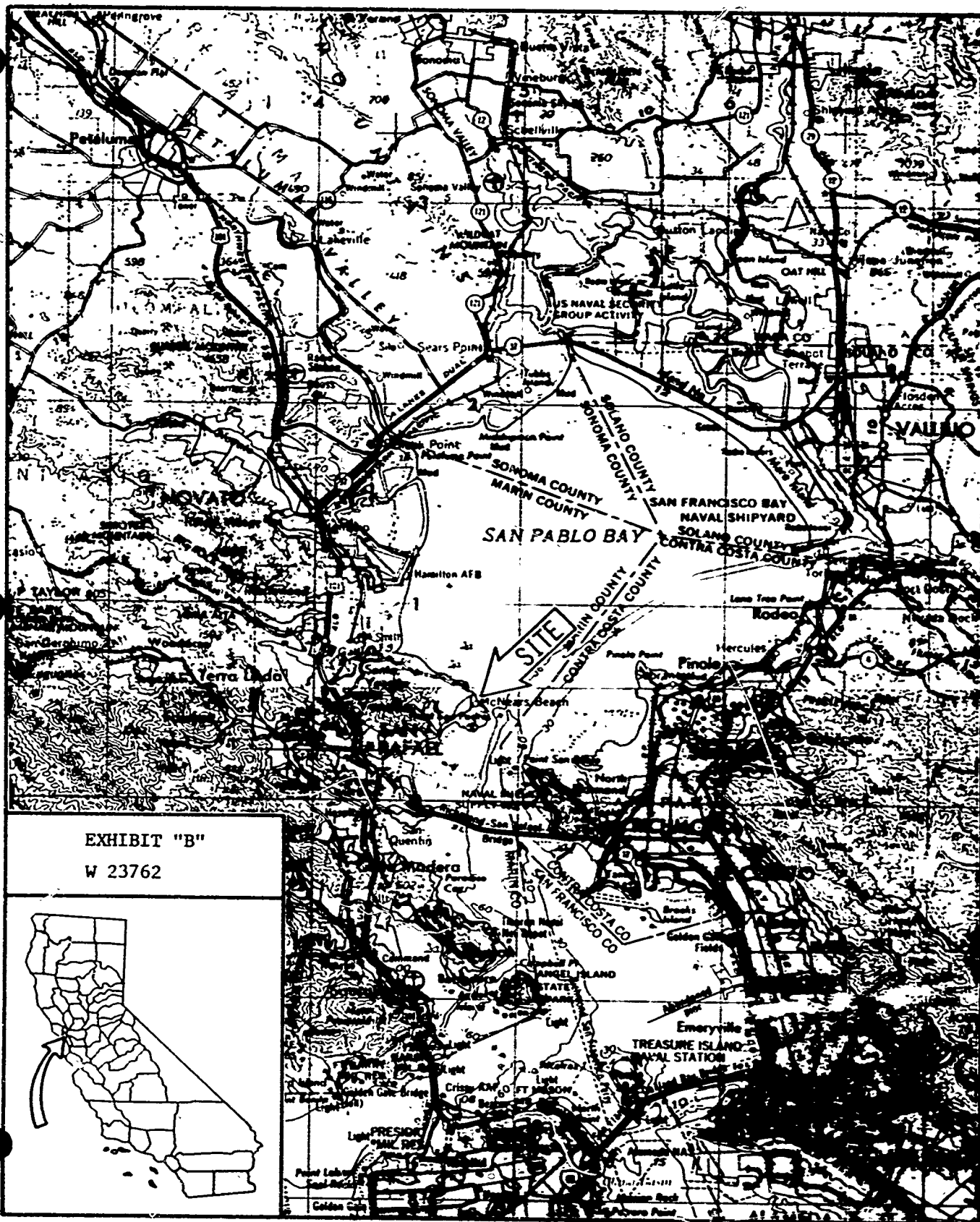

NEGATIVE DECLARATIONMarin County  
Environmental Coordination and Review

Pursuant to: Section 21000 et seq of the Public Resources Code and Marin County Environmental Impact Review Guidelines and Procedures, a Negative Declaration is hereby granted for the following project.

1. Project Name: McNear Beach Park Fishery Pier
2. Location and Description: McNear Beach Park, San Pedro Road and Castro's Way in City of San Rafael. Construct a 500' concrete fishery pier approximately 22' wide by 190' deep and a 15,180 sq ft pier.
3. Project Sponsor: Park and Recreation
4. Findings:

a. Based on the attached Initial Study and without a public hearing, it is my judgment that:

The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
