The Commission took the following action:

Upon motion made by Commissioner Davis, and unanimously approved, the Commission agreed to hold a Commission meeting in Santa Barbara on February 28 for the purpose of hearing additional public comment on the ARCO Coal Oil Point Project.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Davis and seconded by Acting Chairman McCarthy, and assuming concurrence by the applicant, the Commission agreed to extend the final decision date on the project to March 26, the date of the regular March meeting in Sacramento. Commission-Alternate Ordway did not vote.

Acting Chairman McCarthy later moved that the March 26 date be changed to February 17. That request was approved by majority vote. Commission-Alternate Ordway did not vote.

The Commission directed staff to complete the staff report for the February 17 meeting and have it available to all interested parties by no later than February 9.
