OTHER PERIINENT INFORMATION:

1. The proposed lease arta was originally leased to the California and Hawaiian Sugar Company as a portion of Parsel " B " of Lease PRC 2546. That lease was subsequently assigned to Crockett Marine Service, effective August 20, 1984 and was simultaneously amended to delete Parcel "g". However, California and Hawaiian Sugar Company continued to occupy 0.245 acres of Parcel "B" for their existing facilities. They have agreed to a settlement for the continued use and obtain a lease for future use of the premises. The negotiated settlement did not include collection of interest or penzity and staff recommends this be waived.
2. This activity intolves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "enuironmental sigrificant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the $r$ quirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the firciing of the project's consistency bith the use classification as required by 2 cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.
