and Resort Association, a California
general partnership

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 1.685-acre parcel of tide and submerged land
in the Mokelumne River, Andrus Island,
Sacramento County.

LAND USE: Commercial marina.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:
(Authorization; Minute Item No. 10,
November 21, 1983)

Initial period: 30 years beginning August 1,
1983.

Surety bond: \$2,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single
limit coverage of \$500,000.

Consideration: \$3,033 per annum; five-year
rent review.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: P.R.C. 21035 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15378.

2. At its meeting of November 21, 1983, the Commission authorized the issuance of Commercial Lease PRC 5210, Lighthouse Marina and Resort Associates, a General Partnership. Prior to the meeting, that organization was wholly acquired by Advanced Resort Systems, Inc., a Nevada Corporation, by an agreement dated April 19, 1983.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 09 (CONT'D)

3. On May 24, 1984, the Commission authorized an amendment of Lease PRC 5210, to revise the land description and to allow the placement of speed buoys. The executed amendment was transmitted to Advanced Resort Systems, a Nevada Corporation.
4. Advanced Resort Systems, Inc., was later merged into Quality Resorts of California, Inc., a California corporation, by document dated January 23, 1985.
5. Quality Resorts of California, Inc., now wishes to assign its interests in Lease PRC 5210, effective August 31, 1987, to the West Coast Real Estate Corporation. Staff has no objection to this proposal.

GIVE RETROACTIVE CONSENT, BY MINUTE ITEM PUBLICATION, TO THE PRIOR TRANSFERS OF LEASE PRC 5210, FROM A-) LIGHTHOUSE MARINA AND RESORT ASSOCIATION, A CALIFORNIA GENERAL PARTNERSHIP TO ADVANCED RESORT SYSTEMS, INC., AND SUBSEQUENTLY, FROM B-) ADVANCED RESORT SYSTEMS, INC., TO QUALITY RESORTS OF CALIFORNIA, INC., A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION.

3. AUTHORIZE THE ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE PRC 5210, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 31, 1987, FROM QUALITY RESORTS OF CALIFORNIA, INC., ASSIGNOR TO THE WEST COAST REAL ESTATE CORPORATION, ASSIGNEE, FOR A CONTINUED MARINA OPERATION ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 5210

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the Mokelumne River, near the south end of Andrus Island, Sacramento County, California, described as follows:

COMMENCING at USC&GS triangulation station "Andrus Island SW Steel Pole" having California Zone 2 Coordinates of X=2,124,486.96, Y=157,457.15; thence N 08°25' W, 2063.50 feet to an iron pipe monument as shown on that parcel map filed for record in Book 8, Page 18 of Parcel Maps, Sacramento County Official Records; thence along the southeasterly line of Parcel A of said map N 31°33' E, 121.28 feet; thence along the northeasterly line of said Parcel "A", N 36°50' W, 489.68 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said northeasterly line N 45°57' W 455.25 feet; thence N 55°14' W, 255.5 feet; thence leaving said northeasterly line and running into the Mokelumne River the following nine courses:

1. N 33°36' E, 75 feet;
2. S 56°24' E, 240 feet;
3. S 33°36' W, 30 feet;
4. S 56°24' E, 102 feet;
5. N 35°45' E, 45 feet;
6. S 55°29' E, 342 feet;
7. S 38°13' W, 102 feet;
8. S 31°13' E, 39 feet;
9. S 43°45' W, 55 feet to the true point of beginning.

TOGETHER WITH three parcels of submerged land lying immediately beneath speed limit buoys located 20 feet waterward of the docks enclosed in the above described parcel.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark.

Bearings and distances in the above description are based on the California Coordinate System of 1927, Zone 2.

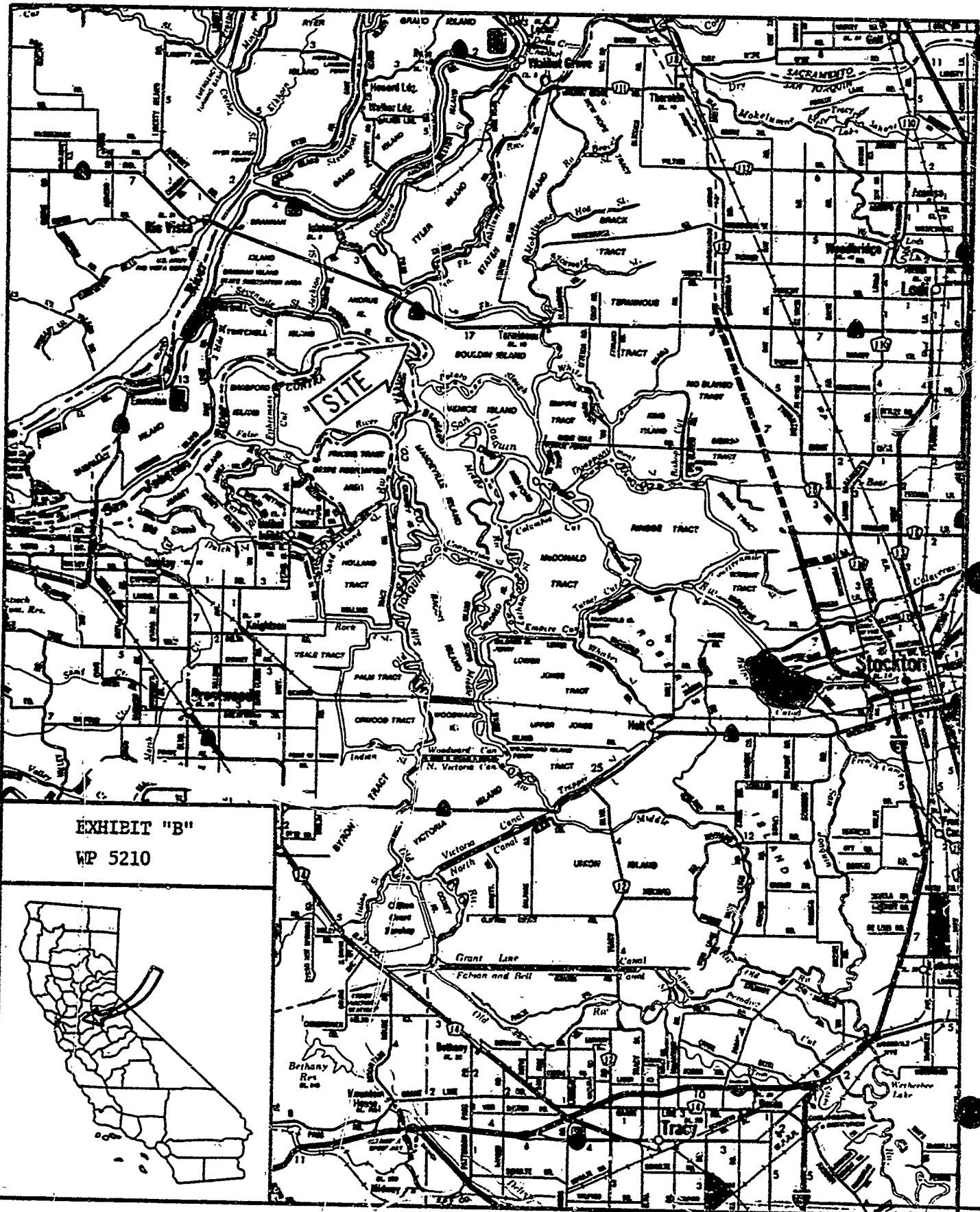
