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## LAND DESCRIPTION

Two (2) parcels of submerged land lying in the bed of the Sacramento River and Butte Slough, in Section 35. T16N, RlW, MDM. Colusa and Sutter Counties, California, being more particularly described as follows:

### PARCEL 1

BEGINNING at the point of intersection of the left bank of the Sacramento River with the right bank of Butte Slough; thence northwesterly along the left bank of the Sacramento River 700 feet; thence southwesterly at right angles to said left bank 60 feet; thence southeasterly parallel to and 60 feet distant from said left bank 700 feet, more or less, to a point 60 feet distant and at right angles to said left bank and the point of beginning; thence northeasterly 60 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark.

### PARCEL 2

BEGINNING at the point of intersection of the left bank of the Sacramento River with the right bank of Butte Slough; thence northeasterly along the right bank of Butte Slough 260 feet; thence southeasterly at right angles to said right bank 95 feet; thence southwesterly at right angles and parallel to said right bank 65 feet; thence northwesterly at right angles 80 feet; thence southwesterly at right angles and parallel to said right bank 195 feet; thence northwesterly at right angles and parallel to said right bank 195 feet; thence northwesterly at right angles 15 feet to the point of beginning.

INCLUDING a ramp extending southeasterly into the southwesterly portion of Parcel 2 above, said ramp being 180 feet long with a variable width.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark.
