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AMENDMENT OF GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE PRC 5373

APPLICANT: Stockton Water Ski Club  
P.O. Box 1666  
Stockton, California 95201

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
A 0.211-acre area of tide and submerged land,  
located in the old channel of the San Joaquin  
River, San Joaquin County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of an existing walkway, floating  
dock, and swim float; placement and maintenance  
of five 5-MPH speed-limit buoys, all utilized  
for recreational purposes.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL PERMIT:

Initial period: 20 years beginning March 1,  
1987.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single  
limit coverage of \$500,000.

Special: The permit restricts the  
utilization of the facilities  
for residential purposes.

CONSIDERATION: \$531.86 per annum; as to the walkway and  
floating dock; and \$110.95 per annum, as to  
the swim float with the State reserving the  
right to fix a different rental on each fifth  
anniversary of the permit.

TERMS OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Initial period: 20 years beginning March 1,  
1987.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single  
limit coverage of \$500,000.

Special:

1. The amendment adds five  
5-MPH speed-limit buoys,  
which increases the annual  
rental and area of use.

2. All other terms and  
conditions of the permit  
remain in full force and  
effect.

CONSIDERATION: \$531.86 per annum; as to the walkway and  
floating dock; \$110.95 per annum, as to the  
swim float; and \$53 per annum, as to five  
speed-limit buoys, with the State reserving  
the right to fix a different rental on each  
fifth anniversary of the permit.

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

Applicant is owner of upland.

1. Applicant is a non-profit California  
corporation incorporated to promote  
social activities among, and recreational  
facilities for, its members.
2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of  
authority and the State CEQA Guidelines  
(14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has  
determined that this activity is exempt  
from the requirements of the CEQA as a

categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structure, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(c)(5).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the activity is consistent with its use classification.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS A CATEGORICAL EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 3, NEW CONSTRUCTION OF A SMALL STRUCTURE, 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905(c)(5).
2. AUTHORIZE THE AMENDMENT OF GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE PRC 5373, EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 1988, TO ADD FIVE 5-MPH SPEED-LIMIT BUOYS WHICH INCREASES THE AREA OF USE AND ANNUAL RENTAL; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$531.86, AS TO THE WALKWAY AND FLOATING DOCK; \$110.95, AS TO THE SWIM FLOAT; AND \$53, AS TO THE FIVE SPEED-LIMIT BUOYS WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT: WITH PROVISION OF A \$1,000 SURETY BOND: AND WITH PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$500,000; FOR MAINTENANCE OF A WALKWAY, FLOATING DOCK, AND A SWIM FLOAT: AND PLACEMENT AND

MAINTENANCE OF FIVE 5-MPH SPEED-LIMIT BUOYS, ALL UTILIZED  
FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON

EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 5373

A parcel of land partially in the north one-half of projected Section 11 and partially in the south one-half of projected Section 2, T2N, R4E, MDM being the lands described in that grant deed dated December 29, 1972 from Edilio Marchetti and Theresa A. Marchetti to Stockton Water Ski Club, a California Corporation, recorded December 29, 1972 in Book 3723, page 24, San Joaquin County Recorder's Office.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM those interests-in-land, if any, which passed by virtue of the patent issued to William I. Pettigrew, Napoleon B. Byene, and Isaac E. Nicholson on May 10, 1872, for the land described in Swamp and Overflowed Survey No. 1106, San Joaquin County.

TOGETHER WITH all that land immediately beneath an existing pier, walkway, swimfloat and 5 speed limit buoys lying adjacent to the above mentioned parcel described in the grant deed recorded December 29, 1972 in Book 3723, page 24, San Joaquin County Recorder's Office, ALSO TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending no more than 10 feet from said pier, walkway, and swimfloat.

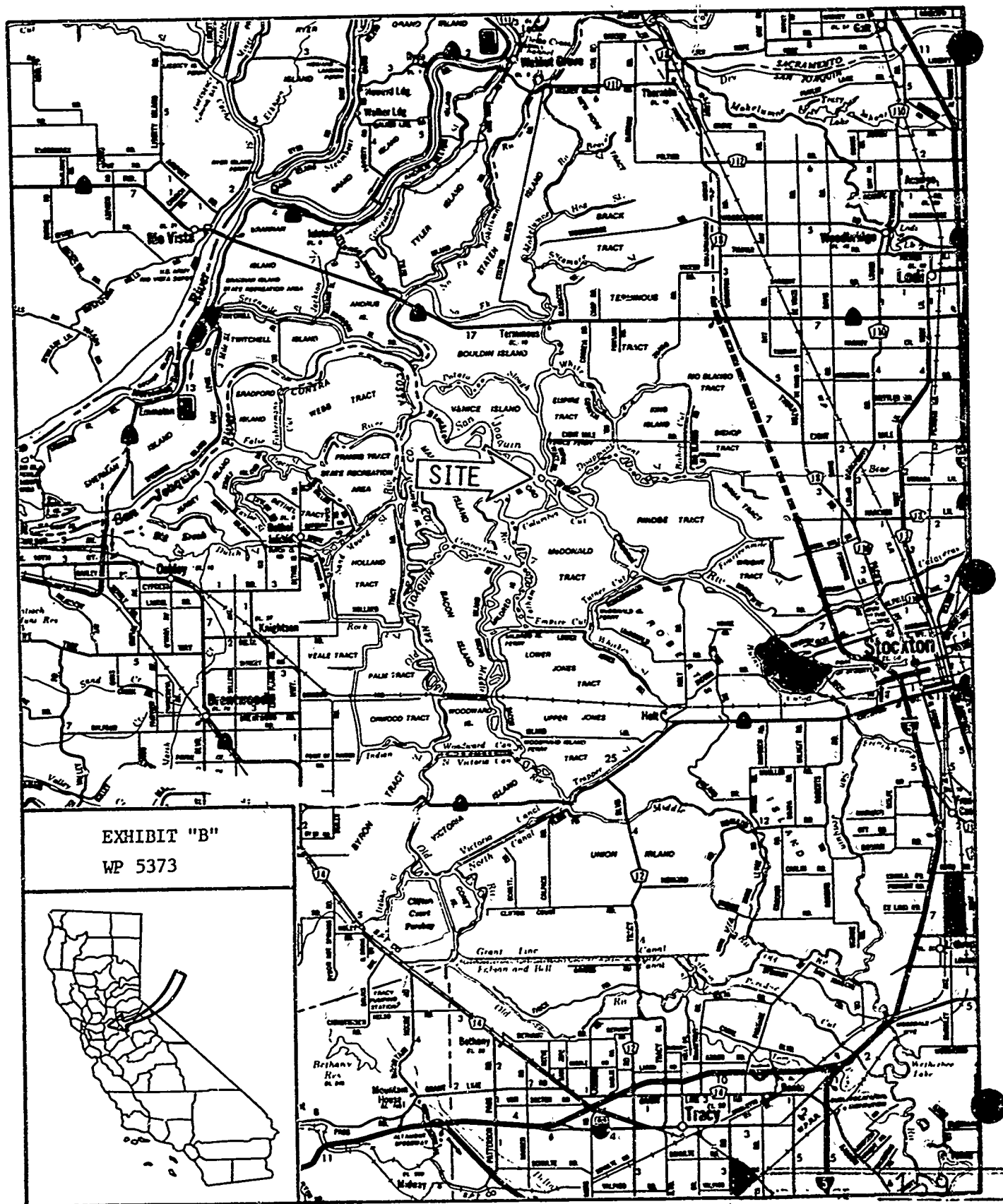
