OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Applicant has applied to install an aerial telephone cable across the Merced River on existing power poles owned by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E). Applicant has received approval from PG&E to install the cable. During the processing of this application, staff found the State Lands Commission had not permitted the existing crossing to PG&E. Staff is currently preparing the amendments for both PG&E master leases; PRC 6827 for over 60ku electrical transmission lines, and PRC 6205 for under 60ky electrical distribution lines, to include the subject crossing. These amendments will come before the Commission for approval at the next Commission meeting.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. but will not affect those significant lands.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15301.
