AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.032-acre parcel of submerged land located in Lake Tahoe at Cedar Flat, Placer County.

LAND USE:

Maintenance of an existing pier utilized for recreational boating.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

15 year's beginning January 1,

1989.

Public liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$500,000.

Special:

- 1. The permit is conditioned on permittee's conformance with the shorezone ordinance of Tahoe Regional Planning Agency.
- 2. The permit is conditioned on the Cedar Flat Improvement Association's authorization and consent of the structure found to be on or adjacent to its lands.
- 3. The permit conforms to the Lyon/Fogerty decision.

CONSIDERATION: \$277.20 per annum; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the permit.
