APPROVAL OF NINE RECREATIONAL PIER PERMITS AND  
TERMINATION OF TWO GENERAL PERMITS - RECREATIONAL USE,  
PRC'S 6715 AND 6716

APPLICANTS: As listed on Exhibit "A" attached

TERMS: Initial period: Ten years.

Renewal options: None.

Filing fee: \$25 (each).

Processing fee: \$45 (each).

CONSIDERATION: No monetary consideration pursuant to  
Section 6503, P.R.C.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicants are littoral landowners as defined  
in Section 6503, P.R.C.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of  
authority and the State CEQA Guidelines  
(14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has  
determined that these activities are exempt

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from the requirements of the CEQA as categorically exempt projects. All projects, as shown on Exhibit "A", are exempt under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, Item Nos. A-I), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.
3. Lake Tahoe Application: The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at Lake Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. This action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in Lake Tahoe. Each of the applications herein are for the continued use of existing piers in the lake, and therefore are not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.
4. All permits covering structures in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.

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5. PRC's 6715 and 6716, respectively, Items H and I, were previously General Permits - Recreational Use, issued to the Bank of California, Trustee for the Mein Trust. Title has been transferred back into natural party names and therefore, each now qualifies for a Recreational Pier Permit.
6. The Bank of California has requested termination of permits PRC's 6715 and 6716 with an effective date of September 13, 1988. Quitclaim deeds transferring the Bank's leasehold interest back to the State of California have been executed.
7. As to the termination of PRC's 6715 and 6716, pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15601), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. AS TO THE TERMINATION OF GENERAL PERMITS, PRC'S 6715 and 6716, FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL, ADM. CODE 15501 BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS NOT A PROJECT AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21065 AND 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15378.
2. AUTHORIZE THE TERMINATION OF PERMITS PRC'S 6715 AND 6716, ISSUED TO THE BANK OF CALIFORNIA, TRUSTEE, WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SEPTEMBER 13, 1988, AND ACCEPTANCE OF

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QUITCLAIM DEEDS TRANSFERRING ITS LEASEHOLD INTEREST BACK TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

3. FIND THAT THESE ACTIVITIES ARE EXEMPT FORM CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECTS, CLASS 1 (EXISTING FACILITIES, ITEM NOS. A THROUGH I), 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905, AND FIND THAT THESE ACTIVITIES ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370 ET SEQ.
4. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF TEN-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER PERMITS TO THE APPLICANTS LISTED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
