CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 32 (CONT'D)

Consideration: \$2,500 per annum or five-percent (5%) of the Gross Income derived from the rental of boat docks and mooring; one-percent (1%) of the Gross Income derived from sources exclusive of dock rentals, mooring and fuel sales; one (1) cent per gallon of fuel sold during the reporting period to a maximum of 100,000 gallons, and 1.5 cents per gallon thereafter, whichever is greater.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
1. Mr. Kenneth P. Gilmore, Lessee of record, passed away on July 29, 1987. His daughter, Denise L. McManus, as Executrix of Mr. Gilmore's estate, has arranged a sale of the leasehold interest to Jerry E. Pendleton and Elsie Pendleton, under an action filed with the Probate Division of the Sacramento Superior Court, Case No. 3664. No person has protested the sale of the leasehold interest to Mr. and Mrs. Pendleton, nor does the staff interpose a protest or objection to such action. Because no one has objected, according to counsel for the Executrix, no court order will be entered.

2. The pending Assignee is in the process of purchasing the adjacent uplands. The Lease Assignment will be effective upon the close of escrow in the uplands purchase, which shall be no later than December 30, 1988.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

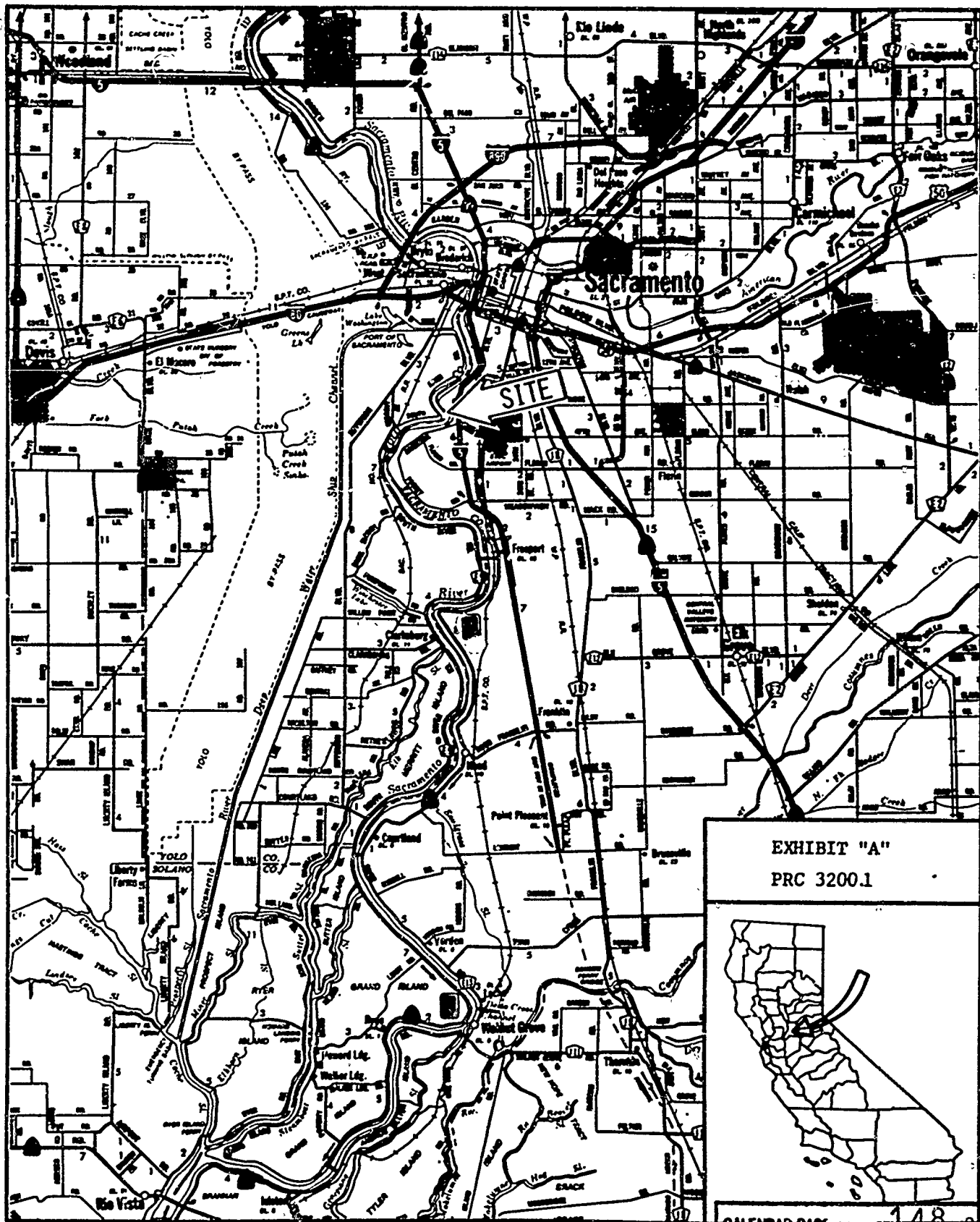
