AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
A 0.089-acre parcel of tide and submerged land  
in the Petaluma River, Marin County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of a rental cabin, walkway, and  
floating dock.

Initial period: Ten years beginning March 1,  
1983 ending February 28, 1993.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On November 29, 1984, the Commission approved a General Lease - Commercial Use, for Virginia Ord and Jean Boewe to use and maintain a rental cabin, walkway, and floating dock on the subject tide and submerged land. The permit is now being assigned to Terence and Pauline Bunton.

2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: P.R.C. 21065 and 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15378.

3. This activity is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "B", which authorizes limited use. The project, as proposed, will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 5274.1

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Petaluma River, Marin County, California, said parcel being immediately beneath a cabin, walkway, and float, TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending no more than 10 feet from said structures, said structures being adjacent to and northerly of that land described as "Parcel Two" in the Quitclaim Deed recorded in Book 3027, page 600, Official Records, Marin County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Petaluma River.

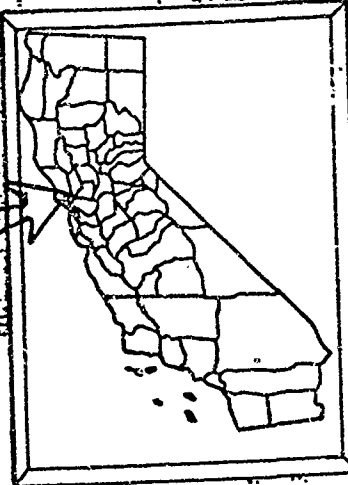
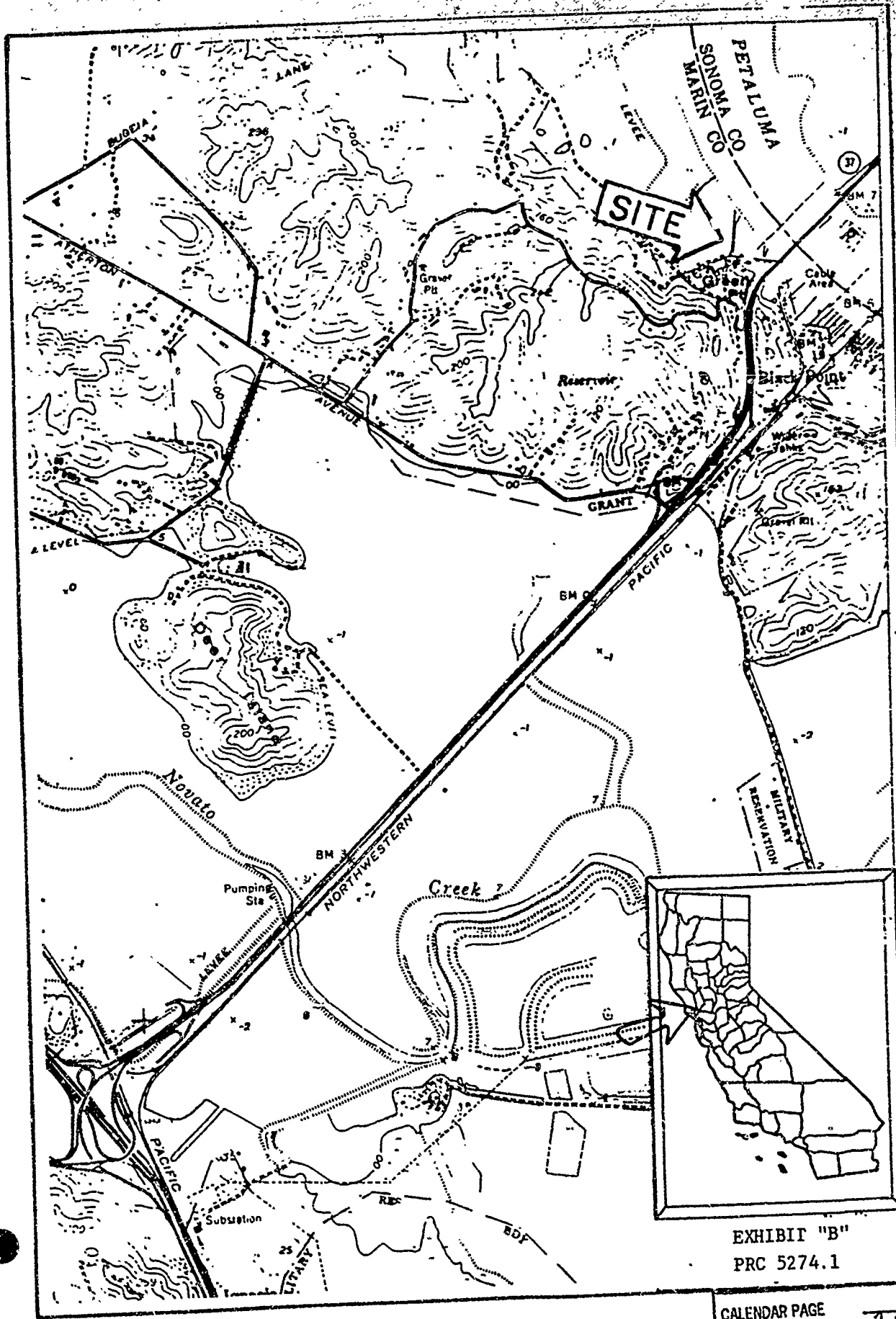
