GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

APPLICANT: GTE California Incorporated
11810 Washington Avenue
P.O. Box 176
Courtland, California 95615

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.220 acre, tide and submerged land,
Steamboat Slough, in Solano and Sacramento
counties.

LAND USE: Installation of two conduits and a fiber optic
cable in the bed of Steamboat Slough as a part
of a fiber optic system.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: Indefinite, beginning June 1,
1989.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt, Section 7901, Public Utilities Code.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2003.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 07 (CONT'D)

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The project under consideration covers the installation, operation, and maintenance of a fiber optic system approximately 9.03 miles long; the project portion affecting sovereign lands is a strip approximately twenty feet wide and 480 feet in length. Two contiguous conduits will be installed: 1) one which will house the fiber optic cable; and 2) the other to be vacant and held in reserve in case of future need.
2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304.

A 20 foot wide strip of tide and submerged land in the bed of Steamboat Slough near Howard Landing, in Solano and Sacramento Counties, California, said strip lying 10 feet on each side of the following described line;

A line parallel with and 1 foot south of the westerly prolongation of the north right of way line of State Road 220 across said Steamboat Slough from said State Road's intersection with Grand Island Road to the easterly levee of Ryer Island.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water marks of Steamboat Slough.

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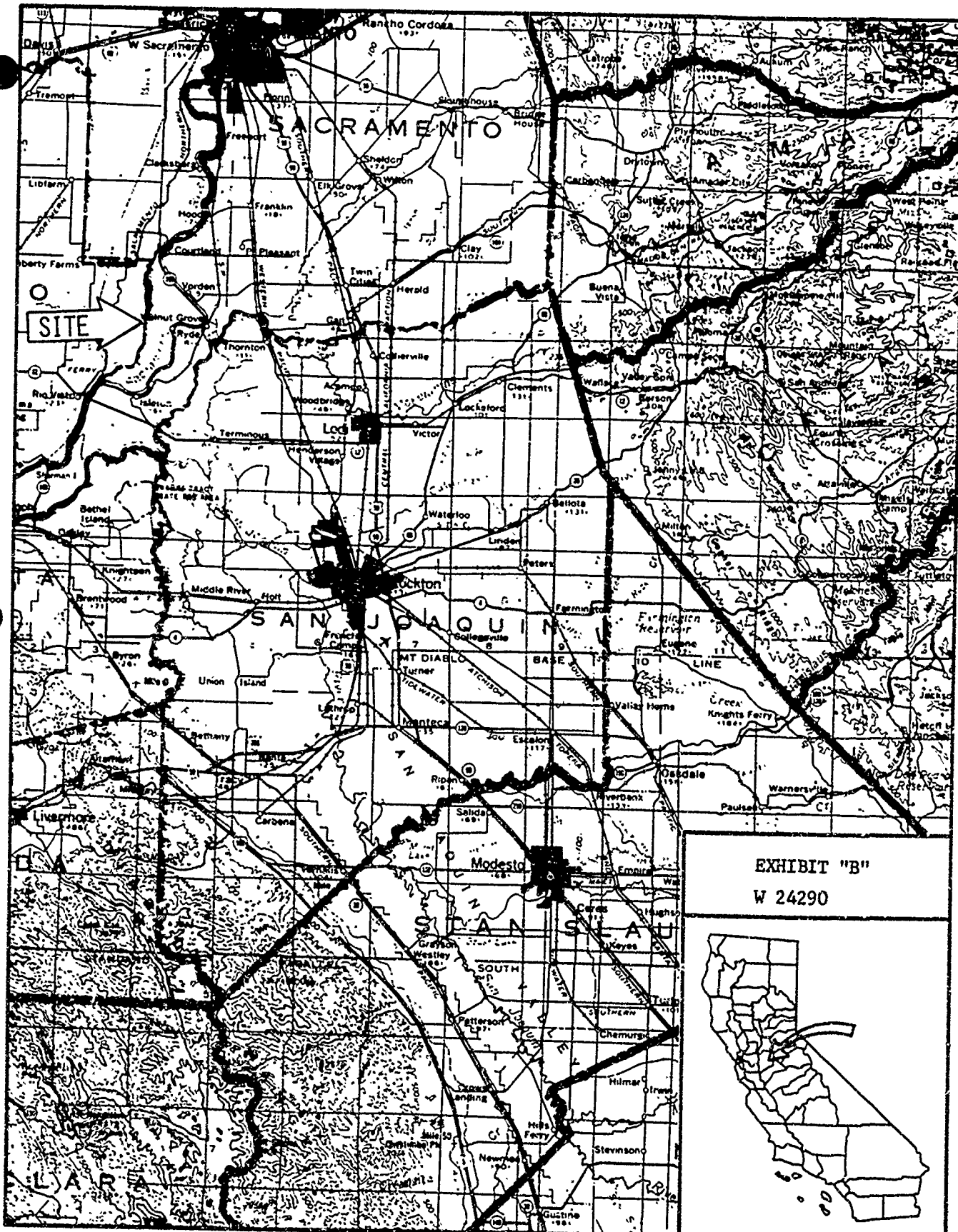
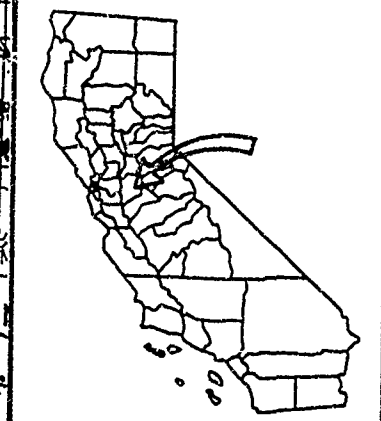

APPLICATION FOR ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

STANDARD PERMIT PROVISIONS:

Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County of Solano, its agents and employees, from any and all claims for loss due to personal injury or property damage arising out of any excavation, construction or other work done pursuant to this permit.

Applicant agrees that any damages arising in the future to personal property placed underground pursuant to this permit shall not be the responsibility of the County of Solano.

Public Safety and convenience and proper traffic control during project shall conform to the requirements set forth in the current "Manual of Traffic Controls". (Sec. 7-1.08 & 1.09, State Specs.)

At least one traffic lane shall be provided at all times. Warning signs supplemented by cones, barricades and flagment shall be provided to direct traffic through site. During non-working hours, two-way traffic shall be provided.

Applicant shall be responsible for determining existence and location of any underground facilities that may conflict with his operation. All work shall be coordinated with the owners of any such facilities.

Applicant shall locate (horizontally and vertically) utilities in the filed upon request of the Public Works.

Area Maintenance Supervisor RON BROWNING (707-429-6311) shall be notified (24 hrs.) in advance of any work.

ADDITIONAL PERMIT PROVISIONS:

- () Installation of conduits under new/unmarked pavement must be bored or jacked.
- (✓) Sawcut or jackhammer A.C. pavement in neat uniform lanes.
- (✓) Road structural section shall be replaced with min. .20' A.C. and .45' A.S. over structural backfill.
- () Final surface course of 3/8" max. or No. 4 (Sec. 19-2, State Specs.) shall be spread and compacted beyond trench cut lines in neat straight lines.
- () Structural backfill (Sec. 19-3, State Specs.) shall be used for trench backfill beneath pavement and within (1') of edge of pavement.
- (✓) Trench backfill shall be composed of a structural backfill material compacted to (95%) relative compaction, placed in (8") lifts.
- (✓) (95%) Compaction requirement for backfill shall be checked by Solano County materials tech., (24) hours notice required (429-6511).
- () Applicant shall provide an armor protective covering on cable at all existing CMP locations for a minimum length of (20') to prevent possible damage to cable from future maintenance of CMP structure.
- (✓) 36" min. cover over line shall be provided.
- () A cash deposit, certified check, approved surety bond, or other acceptable security shall be furnished to insure the performance of the requirements of this permit. The security shall be in the amount of _____.
