1. Lessee has been required by San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission to enter into this lease with State Lands Commission for the purpose of performing certain work on the subject 7.38 acre site as mitigation for the installation of 1625 lineal feet of rock riprap along the south bank of Corte Madera Creek at the Greenbrae Boardwalk Subdivision under PRC 7187, authorized by State Lands Commission on April 12, 1988, Item C-12.

Work to be performed consists of dredging 1100± feet of channels, excavation of two marsh areas, and planting of cordgrass and pickleweed.

- A portion of the mitigation site extends onto lands which the Commission has leased to Marin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (PRC 3485) as a flood-control channel. The County has no objections to the proposed project.
- 3. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$1660.
- 4. An environmental analysis was prepared by the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (SFBCDC) which has been certified by the Secretary for Resources as meeting the requirements of P.R.C. 21080.5. This analysis concluded that the project, as defined, will have no significant environmental effects.
