RATIFY AMENDMENT TO INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION AND STATE LANDS COMMISSION FOR ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

The Commission previously approved an Interagency Agreement between the Department of Justice and the Commission to provide enforcement services for policing of State lands. Justice requested that the agreement be terminated in January due to competing workload demands on their investigator staff. Staff sought an agreement with another State agency with the authority to provide this service. The Department of Parks and Recreation agreed to provide the services of a State Park Ranger III. To continue Enforcement activities for the remainder of the fiscal year, an agreement was entered.

The Department has offered to extend the agreement through January of 1991. The Commission is pursuing enforcement authority for designated SLC staff through legislation now pending.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS NOT A PROJECT AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21065 AND 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15378.
