**SECOND MODIFICATION OF THE 1989-1990
PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET,
LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY
TRANSFER OF FUNDS AMONG BUDGET ITEMS**

The City of Long Beach has submitted to the Commission the Second Modification of the 1989-1990 Plan of Development and Operations and Budget for the Long Beach Unit which transfers funds among budget items to provide for payment of a claim by the United States Department of Energy under the Tertiary Incentive Program. Payment of this claim is being made pursuant to a settlement that the Unit, the City of Long Beach and the State Lands Commission have reached with the Department of Energy.

The Second Modification revises the budget by taking \$2 million from the account for mining rights taxes and placing \$1,925 million of it in the account for prior years expense adjustments and \$0.075 million of it in the account for administrative overhead. This transfer will provide adequate funding to pay the Department of Energy claim.

The City of Long Beach, as Unit Operator, has approved the Second Modification and requests approval by the Commission. The staff has reviewed the City's request and recommends that approval be given.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

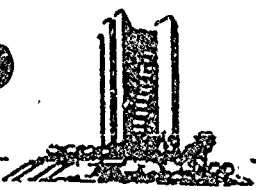
