Staff initially advised Mr. Williamson in August of 1976 that Commission authorization was required for the construction and maintenance of a pier on State lands. The pier was constructed and continues to exist on State lands without a lease or permit. Williamson has refused to apply for such a lease or permit despite repeated attempts by staff to get him to do so. Some thirty demand letters have been sent by staff since the first contact date in 1976 with no response to date.


