OTHER IRTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that these activities are exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as categorically exempt projects. These projects are exempt under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, Items A. C-Q); and Class 3 (New Construction, Item B), 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 2905.

- 2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.
- 3. Lake Taboe Application: All permits issued at Lake Taboe include special language in which the permittee/lessee agrees to protect and replace or restore, if required, the habitat of Rorippa subumbellata, commonly called the Taboe Yellow Cress, a State-listed endangered plant species.
- 4. All applicants at Lake Tahoe have been notified that the public has a right to pass along the shorezone and the permittee must provide a reasonable means for public passage along the shorezone occupied by the permitted structure.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO.C 03 (CONT'D)

- 5. All permits covering structures in take Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State and the site shall he cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.
- 6. Prior to issuance of the permits for facilities at Lake Tahoe, staff will arrange for the site to be physically inspected for purposes of evaluating the impact of the project on the public trust.
