PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT AND APPROVAL OF RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP

APPLICANT:

California Department of Transportation

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An approximate 3.91-acre parcel of sovereign land located in
the bed of the Yuba River, Yuba County.

LAND USE:

Highway purposes pursuant to Section 101.5 of the Streets
and Highways Code, specifically for the replacement of the
Highway 20 bridge crossing at Parks Bar approximately
17 miles east of Marysville.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Indefinite period from date the permit is approved by the
State Lands Commission.

CONSIDERATION:

As set forth by Section 101.5, Streets and Highways Code and
the public use and benefit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2003.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
2. A Negative Declaration, SCH 89020232, was prepared and adopted for this project by the Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
3. This project will replace the Parks Bar Bridge on State Route 20 in Yuba County, 17 miles northeast of the city of Marysville. The bridge approaches will be replaced and approximately 1.5 miles of State Route 20 will be realigned. The project is needed to replace an obsolete and structurally deficient bridge and to ensure safe sight distances on the bridge approaches.
4. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$351.90.
5. Staff has been informed by CALTRANS that the designation "Access Prohibited" shown on Exhibit "A" is for the purpose of limiting motor vehicles from entering the bridge right-of-way from adjoining lands. The bridge will be constructed with a sufficient width for bicycles and pedestrians, both of which shall be permitted to cross the Yuba River on the new bridge.


IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will replace the Parks Bar Bridge (No. 16-11) on State Route 20 in Yuba County 17 miles northeast of the City of Marysville. The bridge approaches will be replaced and approximately 1.5 miles of State Route 20 will be realigned. The project is needed to replace an obsolete and structurally deficient bridge and to ensure safe sight distances on the bridge approaches. Approximately 35 acres of new right-of-way will be needed.

State Route 20 serves as a west-east connector route between the western portion of the Sacramento Valley and the western slope of the Sierra Nevadas. The project is in a rural area within the foothill of the Sierras between the cities of Marysville and Grass Valley. This area is used primarily for recreation, seasonal livestock grazing and mining.

This is to advise you that the California Department of Transportation and the California Transportation Commission have approved the above-described project and have made the following determinations:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. A copy of the Negative Declaration may be examined at the Department of Transportation office located at 703 B Street, Marysville, CA.
