STATUS REPORT ON EFFORTS TO RECOUP FULL COSTS OF  
PROCESSING APPLICATIONS FOR LEASES AND PERMITS

The Commission, at its December 12, 1990 meeting, authorized staff to pursue a policy of actual cost recovery for the processing of applications for leases and permits. The program was implemented for all applications received after January 1, 1991.

The attached exhibit displays the number of agreements executed by applicants since the inception of the policy and their relative value. The policy was applied to all new applications received after January 1, 1991. The time necessary to establish procedures, complete the applications, execute the reimbursement agreements and begin processing resulted in few costs being documented prior to March 1. Too few application files have been completed thus far to provide any valid statistical basis for determining the average cost of the more typical transactions or the amount of costs earned versus those anticipated. There have been fewer than 10% of the reimbursement agreements issued which have not been returned for whatever reason and four projects have been withdrawn. This suggests that the non-participation rate has been relatively low.

The policy is fully implemented and, on the basis of the agreements entered into thus far, potential cost recovery appears to be sufficient to support the staff funded as a result. This will become evident as transactions are completed and files closed. Staff will report these findings to the Commission as they become available.
