CLOSING ACCOUNTS OF TIDELAND OIL REVENUE EXPENDITURES FOR SUBSIDENCE VERTICAL AND HORIZONTAL MEASUREMENTS AND STUDIES, CITY OF LONG BEACH, LOS ANGELES COUNTY 1990-91 FISCAL YEAR

SUBSIDENCE PROJECT:

Subsidence vertical and horizontal measurements and studies in the City of Long Beach Harbor District between July 1, 1990 and June 30, 1991.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Total costs amount to \$255,032.05 and are payable to the City from tideland oil revenues in accordance with Chapter 138 Section 4:(d).

STATUTORY AUTHORIZED:

Chapter 138/'64 1st E.S., Sections 1(e) and 4(d).

AB 884:

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On June 11, 1990, the Commission granted prior approval to the City of Long Beach for \$245,000 in subsidence cost expenditures to be used in the conduct of vertical and horizontal measurements and studies in the Long Beach Harbor District during the 1990-1991 fiscal year.

On March 5, 1991, prior approval of an additional \$20,000 was authorized by the Commission to meet anticipated increased vertical measurement costs due mainly to replacement of obsolete surveying equipment together with related staff training and computer applications. These are non-recurring costs.

The work consists of analysis and interpretation of data developed from twice yearly elevation and linear surveys carried out through an established network of ground control points dispersed throughout the project

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area. The purpose is to detect the occurrence, if any, of subsidence of the land surface. The vertical (elevation) surveys are conducted each May and November and the horizontal (linear) surveys each February and August. No significant change in the Harbor District land surface was detected during 1990-91.

Expenditures for the vertical measurements and studies were more than the prior approval amount of \$255,000 by \$5,016.69 (2.0%). Higher operating costs incurred due to extended interference with field work from cargo handling activities and from a personnel salary overhead rate increase including the replacement of surveying equipment increased the survey costs. The over-expenditure was absorbed by the Harbor Department. The cost of the horizontal measurements and studies was less than the \$10,000 amount approved by \$2,421,19 (24.2%). A staff audit confirms the incurred charges.

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

CONDITIONS FULFILLED:

- That the amounts, if any, to be allowed ultimately as subsidence costs deductible under Chapter 138/'64 1st E.S., Section 4(d), would be determined by the Commission upon an engineering review and final audit by Commission staff after the work was completed.
- 2. That the scope of work performed is essentially in conformance with details of such work as previously defined by the Commission.


