APPROVE A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT INYO COUNTY

APPLICANT:

U. S. Geological Survey Denver Federal Center Box 25046 Denver, Colorado 80225-0046

AREA, AND TYPE LAND:

State sovereign lands in Owens Lake Bed in Inyo County.

LAND USE:

Drill one 1,000-foot core-hole in Section 15, T18S, R37E M.D.M.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

One year.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee of \$25.00 and expense deposit of \$1,500.00 due and payable upon Commission authorization of the Geological Survey Permit.

PROPOSED PROJECT:

The U.S. Geological Survey (U.S.G.S.) proposes to drill a 1,000-foot core-hole at Owens Lake, Inyo County, California to obtain scientific information on past climate-controlled variations in the size, depth and salinity of ancestral Owens Lake and study the variations in the sediments, fossils and pore-water chemistry preserved in the stratigraphic section beneath the surface of Owens Lake.

The hole will be drilled with a truck-mounted rotary-type drill rig. The hole will be drilled with water, and no domestic or agricultural water supplies can be affected by the proposed operations. Drilling time is expected to take from four to six weeks.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO S. 2. 4 (CONT'D)

The site for the project is near the salt crystallization ponds operated by the State's lessee, Lake Minerals Corporation, in Section 15, T18S, R37E MDBM. USGS has an agreement with Lake Minerals to use the existing road and to develop a small off-road area for USGS equipment.

Commission staff will have access to the drill site at all times. All data obtained will be made available to the Commission as soon as it can be compiled. Upon completion, the core hole will be abandoned in accordance with the State Department of Water Resources Bulletin 74-90 entitled Water Well Standards: State of California, dated January, 1990.


