OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The State Lands Commission has patented the majority of lands in the section, reserving fee title to several right-of-way easements to the State. Pursuant to negotiations this past year, it was determined that purchase, as opposed to lease, of the subject parcel would be in the best interest of both parties.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a statutorily exempt project. The project is exempt because it involves an action taken pursuant to the School Land Bank Act, P.R.C. 8700, et seq.

Authority: P.R.C. 8710.

- 3. The consideration of \$4,300 will be deposited in the School Land Bank Fund to facilitate the management of school lands for the purpose of generating revenue and carrying out the goals of the School Land Bank Act, the State Lands Commission will be acting as trustee for the School Land Bank Fund, pursuant to Division 7.7 of the P.R.C.
- 4. Staff has filed a General Plan for this activity with the Legislature, pursuant to P.R.C. 6373.

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
