BACKGROUND:

State oil and gas lease PRC 2955 was issued on December 20, 1962 to Texaco, Inc. On November 29, 1984, Texaco assigned this lease to Phillips Petroleum Company.

The lease consists of approximately 4,250.14 acres of tide and submerged lands within the Refugio Offshore Field, Santa Barbara County.

Resumption of drilling was authorized for this lease on April 22, 1982. Two exploratory wells have been drilled on this lease by Texaco, Inc. The first well was drilled in 1965 and reached a total depth of 9,748 feet. The second well was drilled in 1982 from an onshore location to a total depth of 7,022 feet. Both wells were plugged and abandoned without discovering commercial quantities of oil and gas.

P.R.C. 6804.1 and lease paragraph 6 permit the Lessee to make at any time a written quitclaim of all rights under the lease or of any portion of the leased lands comprising a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in a compact form. The quitclaim is effective on the date it is filed with the State, subject to the continued obligation of the lessee and its surety to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and to abandon all wells drilled on the leased lands.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 3 8 (CONT'D)

On March 26, 1992, the Commission received Phillips' "Quitclaim of Oil and Gas Lease" for State oil and gas lease PRC 2955. This document is dated March 18, 1992 and quitclaims to the State all of the Lessee's right, title and interest in and to the leased lands described in Exhibit "A".

A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the lease, that the Lessee has complied with all applicable laws and lease provisions and has paid all rentals and royalties.

1. All wells drilled on and into the leased lands were plugged and abandoned in accordance with Division of Oil and Gas requirements (see Exhibit "C").

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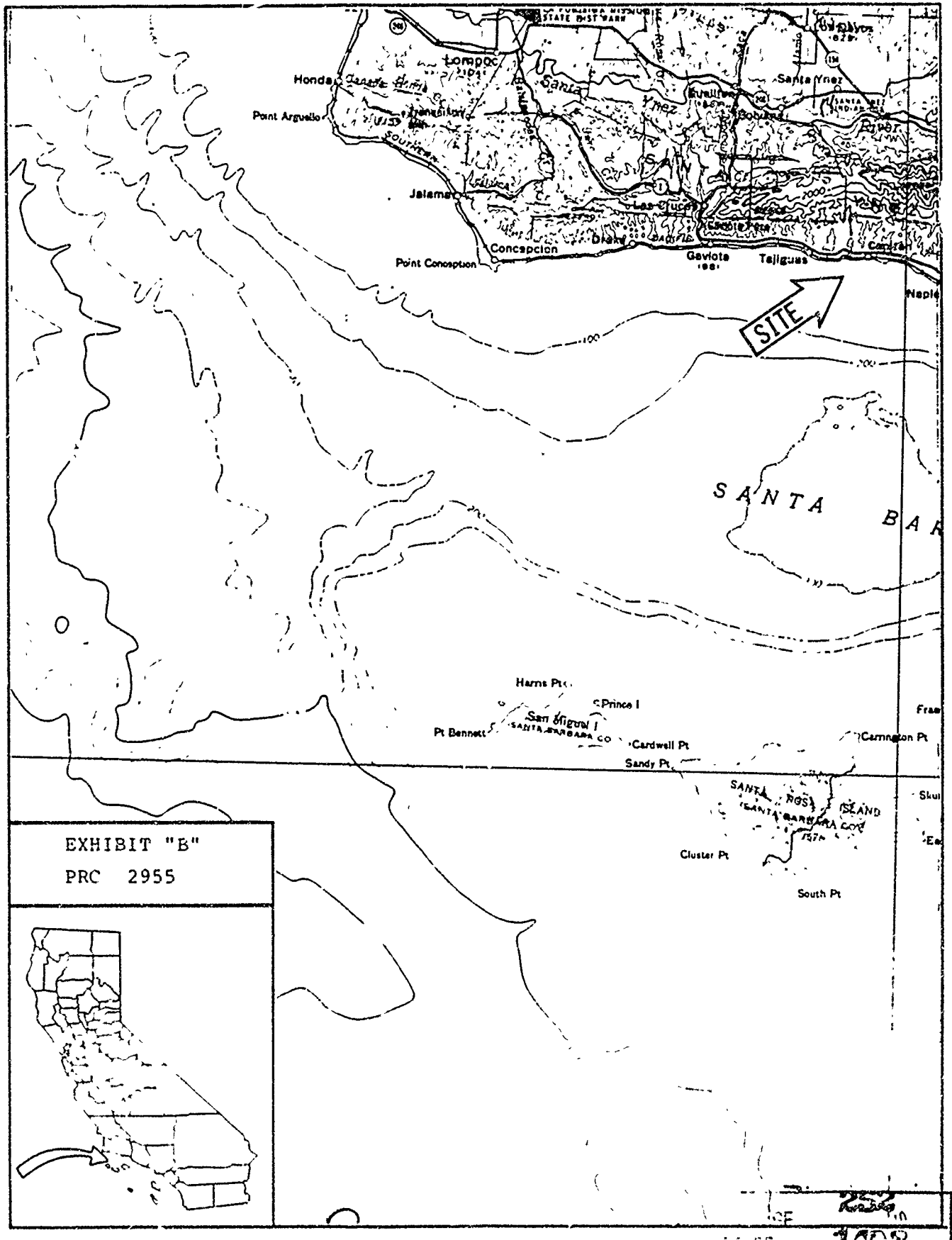

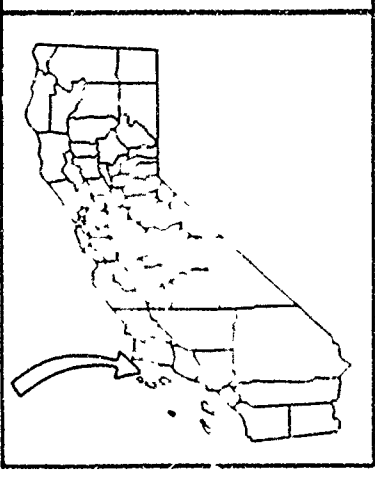
