

- Applicant is a public corporation operating as a 1. municipal utility which supplies water, generates electricity, and provides other services that benefit California's citizens on a statewide basis. The proposed monitoring sites will represent an enhancement of the existing monitoring system which applicant presently utilizes in the gathering of statistical data that enables it to fulfill its obligations to water rights holders, fisheries, and specific flood control The purpose of the proposed facilities requirements. is the measurement of both the flow and temperature of the river at the two proposed sites. The information provided by this project will allow the applicant to better manage Mokelumne River resources.
- 2. The annual rental value of the two sites are estimated to be \$100 each site.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. 




