- 1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 7, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15808, because it consists of an action taken by a regulatory agency to assure the maintenance, restoration, or enhancement of a natural resource.
- 2. This activity includes one 440-acre parcel of land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 3. On November 29, 1982, the Commission approved an Interagency Agreement whereby Department of Fish and Game managed, on behalf of the Commission, the surface of 3496.52 acres of School land in Lake and Napa counties.
