AUTHORIZE, AS BOTH STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND  
SCHOOL LAND BANK TRUSTEE, OFFERING FOR SALE A PARCEL OF  
STATE SCHOOL LAND IN IMPERIAL COUNTY

**PARTY:**

State Lands Commission

Pursuant to P.R.C. 8700 (School Land Bank Act) and the School Land Management Study, staff is identifying parcels of land scattered throughout the State that have a possible highest and best use for sale for surface development. Staff has made a preliminary determination that a 640±-acre parcel of State school land in Imperial County fits within the above-mentioned criteria.

Staff proposes that the Commission authorize offering the property for sale by competitive bid. The minimum bid of \$170,000± is fair market value; any associated costs incurred in preparing the sale will be collected prior to the issuance of a patent.

Final bids on the property will be presented to the Commission for approval and acceptance.

SUBSEQUENT COMMISSION ACTION, IN CONFORMANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS, WILL BE REQUIRED TO ACCEPT BIDS, APPROVE ANY SALE, AND ISSUE A PATENT.

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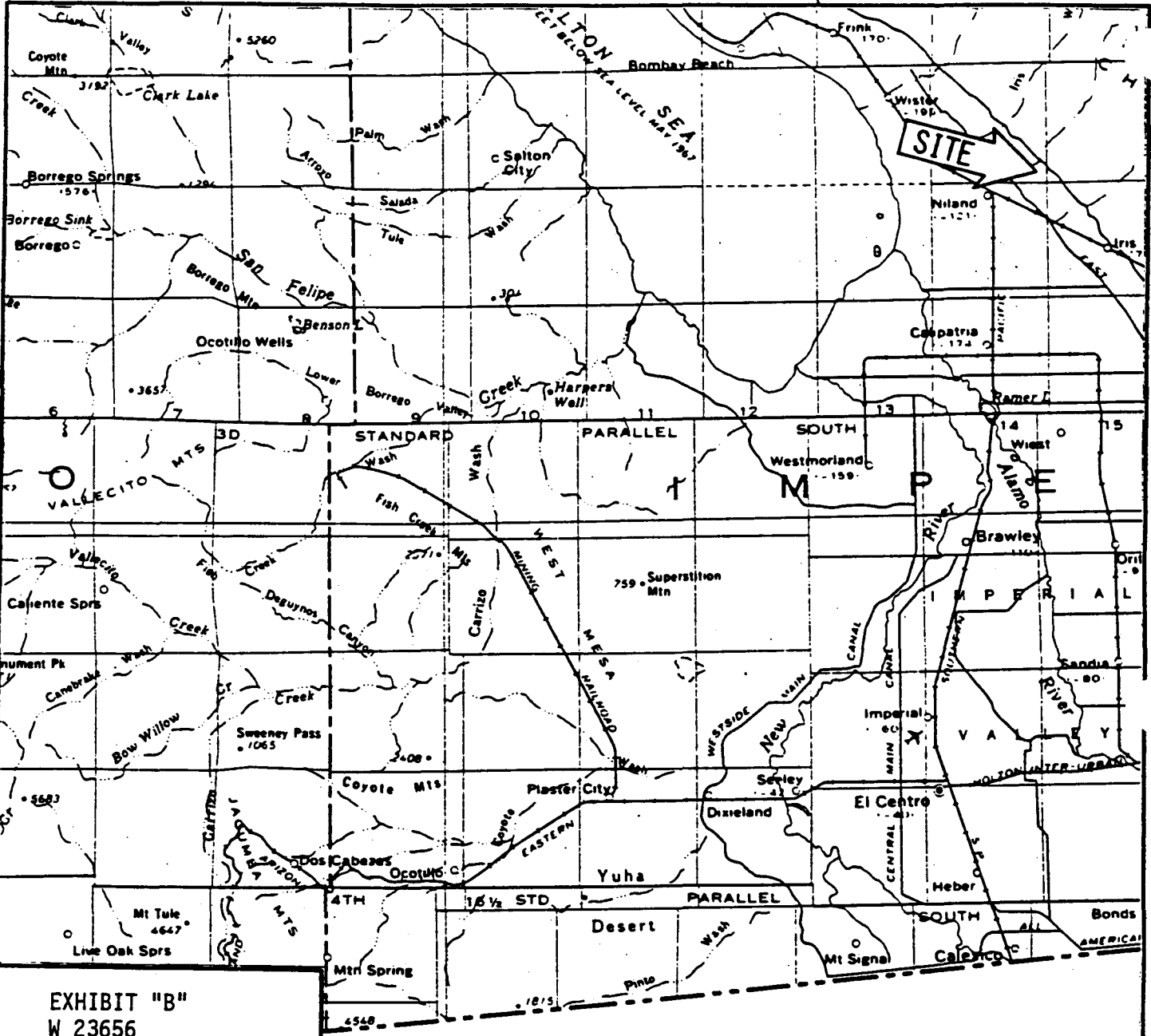
