OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This project involves enhancement and restoration of low lying wetlands adjacent to the Napa River at the John F. Kennedy Park, City of Napa. The City plans to install a 48-inch culvert between the marsh and the Napa River to manage the frequency and duration of ponding in the park wetlands. The existing river bank is faced with rock riprap and broken concrete. During the installation of the outfall the existing rock riprap will be removed and replaced.
- 2. The proposed project will be carried out using heavy equipment from the shore side of the river bank.

 Backhoe and excavators will be used from the land side of the bank to do all earth work.
- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 4. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by the City of Napa (SCH 90030885). The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document. The Negative Declaration included a five-year program to monitor on-site physical and biological changes as part of the enhancement process.




EXHIBIT "A"
